Good afternoon Chairman Weisz and Members of the Committee. I am Lisa Clute, Executive Officer of First District Health Unit. First District Health Unit serves Bottineau, Burke, McHenry, McLean, Renville, Ward and Sheridan Counties.

On March 3, 2010 the Administrators from all local public health units met and discussed the immunization study and their current financial status regarding immunizations.

Local Public Health Unit's Cash Flow Status is indicated on the attached spread sheet.

Administrators stated that funds from SB2333 and the high volume of flu vaccinations administered last year assisted them financially.

Administrators heartily support the Study and look forward to working with the Contractor and the State Health Department to identify efficiencies that could be implemented to improve our delivery system of Immunizations. We believe it is important to wait for the results of the Study to determine what the next steps should be regarding immunizations. There are still issues to be resolved regarding the billing and data entry however I'm confident that the Study will identify strategies to improve those capabilities.
