Re: Mountrail County Road Impacts

Dear Chairman Cook:

I am writing you today to ask for your support of the Mountrail County Commissioners' request for additional state funding needed to mitigate impacts to county roads due to EOG Resources' (EOG) and other oil and gas company operations. EOG believes that keeping North Dakotans safe is job one and keeping county and township roads properly maintained is paramount to their safety. Proper road maintenance also reduces wear and tear on the local citizen's vehicles as well as our operational equipment and vehicles.

For the 2010 drilling season, EOG estimates that our exploration and production operations in Mountrail County will generate approximately 190 truck trips per day on local roads. This estimate is for heavy duty trucks used for water and oil hauling, rig movement, etc. and does not include light duty trucks. And, this estimate is for just one of the companies operating in Mountrail County. Suffice it to say there is a significant volume of heavy truck traffic impacting the condition of county and township roads.
