Spillovers of knowledge

- SSTI identified strategies:
 - Identify and remove barriers to commercialization of university developed technology
 - Encourage commercialization of university-developed technology
 - Encourage commercialization of federal lab technology
 - Provide seed funding to industry associations and councils
 - Improve competitiveness of existing manufacturers



Physical infrastructure

- NDSU Research and Technology Park
- UND Research Enterprise and Commercialization Park
- Growth and interest in local business incubators
- Entrepreneurship Awards program provides financing to business incubators



Technically skilled workforce

- North Dakota Workforce System
- Workforce Enhancement Grants
- Operation Intern
- Experience North Dakota and other recruitment efforts
- Legislative efforts relating to STEM



Capital

- Existing programs:
 - Angel Fund Tax Credit
 - Seed Capital Investment Tax Credit
 - New Venture Capital Program
 - ND Development Fund
 - Beginning Entrepreneur Loan Guaranty Program
- Key challenge is attracting capital from outside our borders
