Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

A concurrent resolution authorizing the Budget Section of the Legislative Management to hold the required legislative hearings on state plans for the receipt and expenditure of new or revised block grants passed by Congress.

Minutes:

Chairman Delzer called the committee to order. Roll was called and a quorum was declared. Yesterday, Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute gave me some maps that had been requested when they presented to us; those have been passed out, see attachment 1. If you have any further requests, let us know. We'll hear a number of bills today, and take action on a few of them. We'll open the hearing on HCR 3002.

Sara Chamberlin, Fiscal Analyst, Legislative Council: I am here to present information on HCR 3002, and am neither for nor against the bill. During the interim LC staff contacted state agencies receiving federal funds to determine which agencies received block grants. The community services block grant administered by the Department of Commerce Division of Community Services was the only block grant identified. Currently there are no other grants that require legislative hearing. The required public hearing for the community services block grant was held as a part of the Appropriations hearing on the Department of Commerce on January 13, 2011. The Budget Section, and subsequently Legislative Management, recommends HCR 3002 to authorize the holding of the required legislative hearings for the receipt of new federal block grant funds during the period from the adjournment of the 62nd Legislative Assembly through September 30, 2013.

Chairman Delzer: Questions by the committee? This is a resolution we pass every year. Is there any further testimony on 3002? Any opposition? We'll close the hearing on 3002.

Representative Thoreson: I move do pass for HCR 3002 to be placed on the consent calendar.

Representative Skarphol: I second.

Chairman Delzer: Any questions by the committee? We checked it out, this was on the consent calendar last year.

Representative Kaldor: Did we hold hearings? I know when the Budget Section meets we get a report, does that constitute a hearing?

Chairman Delzer: I don't know that we did, but this allows us to do it if we need to.

Allen Knudson, LC: That's correct, there haven't been any hearings held by the Budget Section, but this would authorize that in the event there was a new federal block grant that required the legislature to hold a hearing. The one on Community Services was handled through E&E division as part of the Department of Commerce hearing.

Chairman Delzer: Any further discussion? The clerk will call the roll for a do pass to be placed on the consent calendar. Motion carries. Representative Thoreson, we'll list you as the carrier. We're scheduled for three bills on higher ed next, and we'll open the hearings on those when they get here. Until then we'll be at ease.

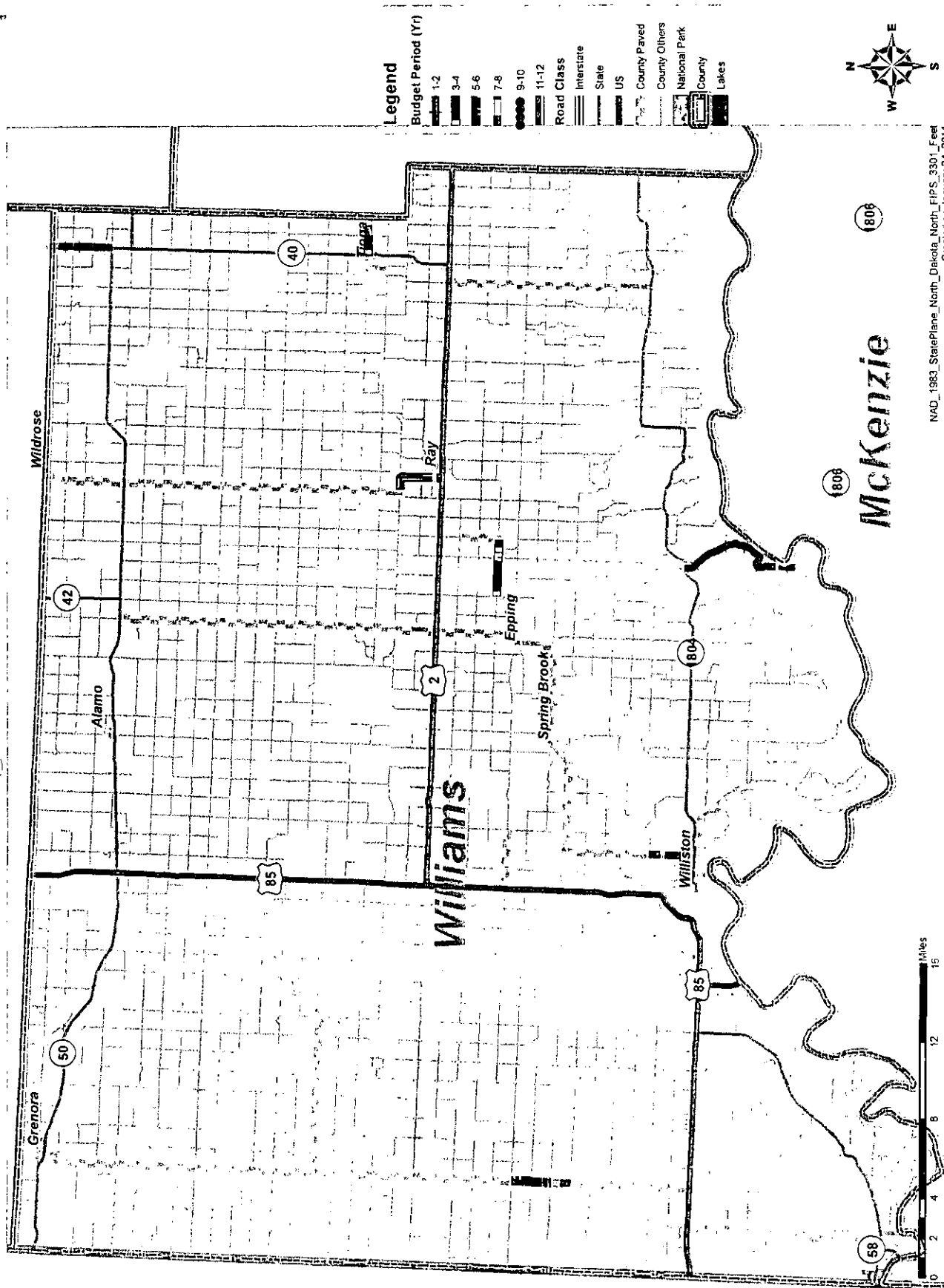

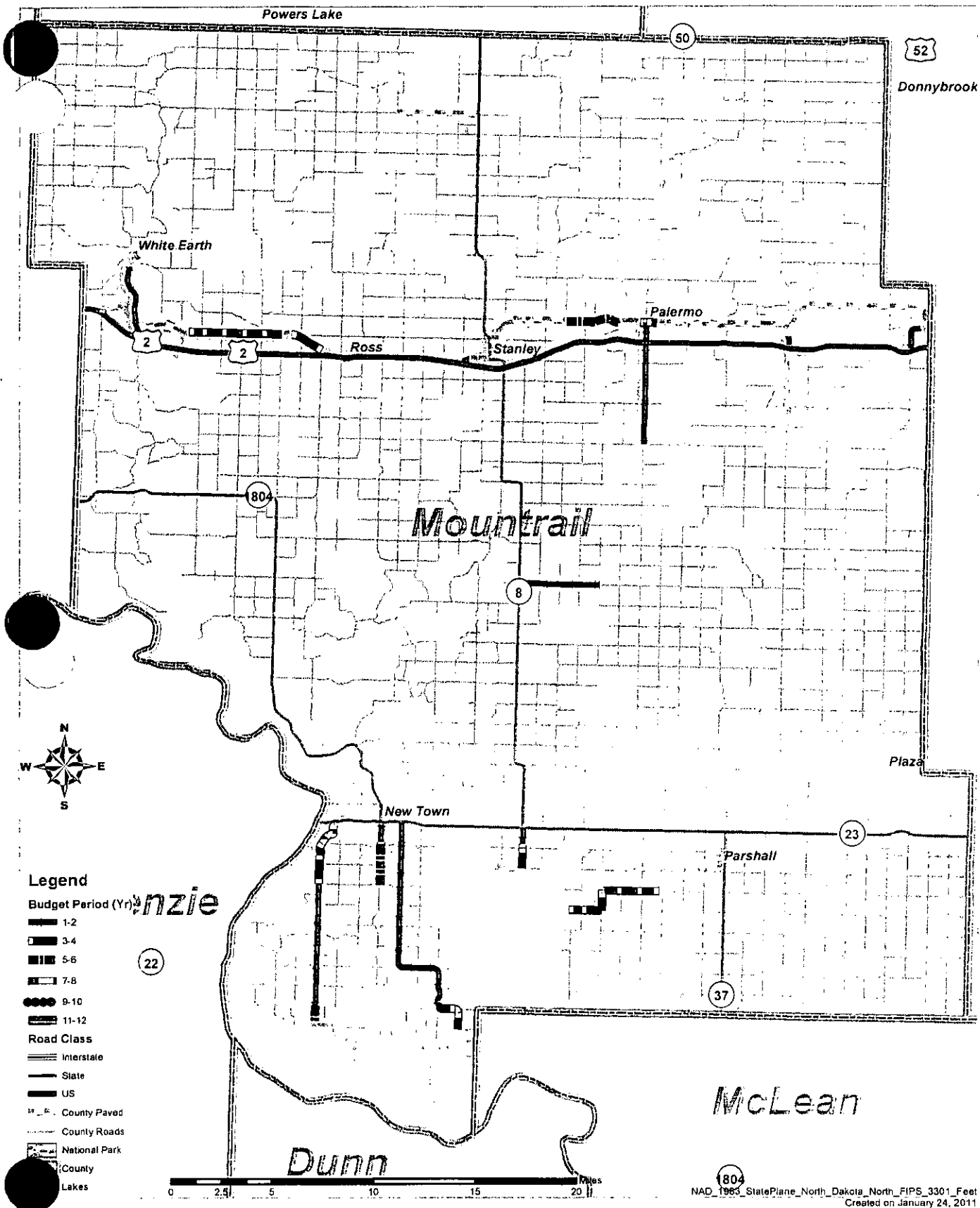

Planned County Road Improvements Williams County

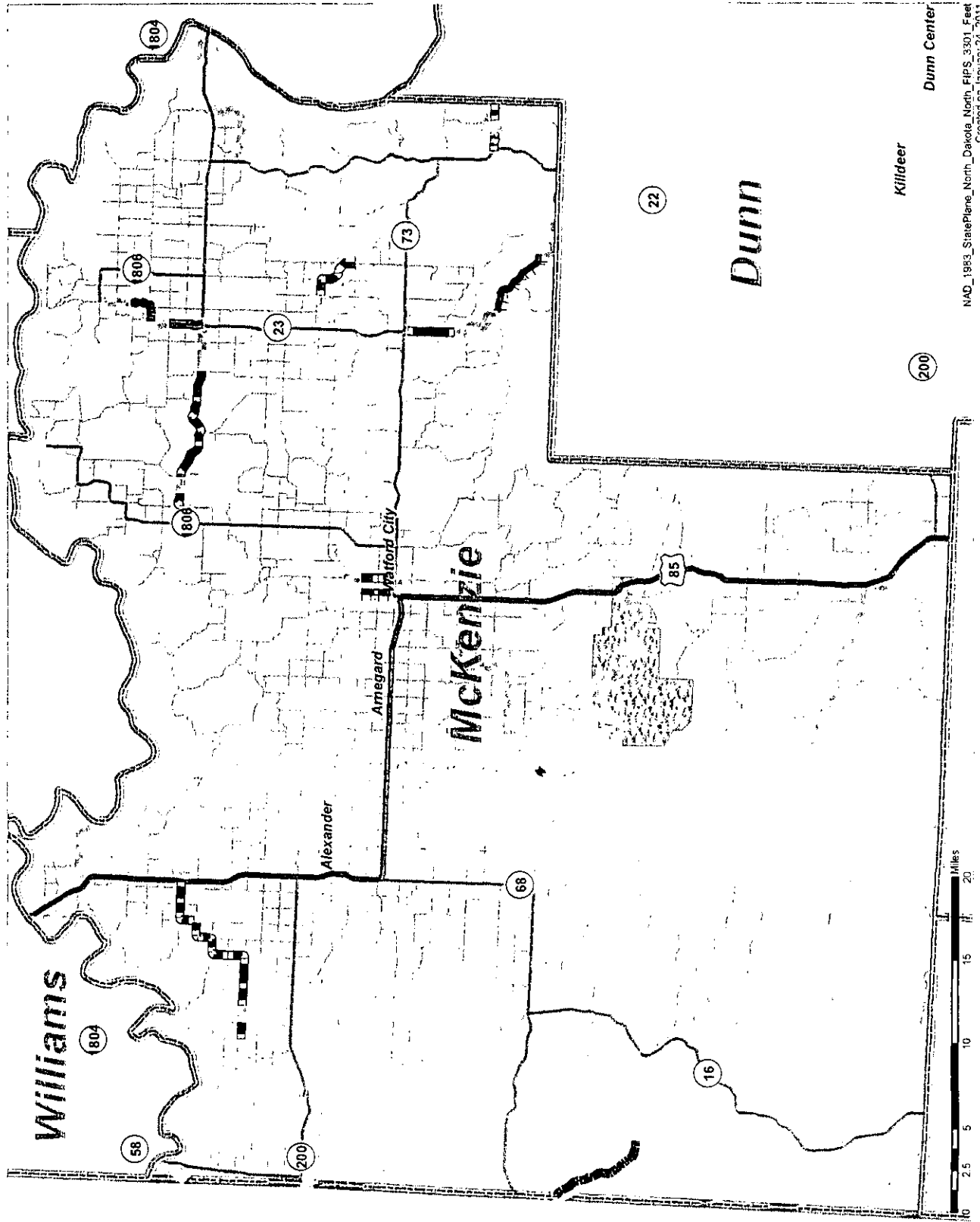

HCR 3002 - Overview

March 2, 2011

Mr. Chairman, members of the committee:

For the record, my name is Sara Chamberlin and I am a Fiscal Analyst for the Legislative Council. I am here to present information on House Concurrent Resolution 3002, I appear neither for nor against the bill, but just to provide information and answer any questions you may have.

House Concurrent Resolution 3002 relates to the authorization of the Budget Section of the Legislative Management to hold the required legislative hearings on state plans for the receipt and expenditure of new or revised block grants.

During the interim Legislative Council staff contacted state agencies receiving federal funds to determine which agencies receive block grants that require legislative hearings. The results of the survey revealed one block grant, the community services block grant administered by the Department of Commerce Division of Community Services. The required public hearing for the community services block grant was held as part of the appropriations hearing for the Department of Commerce on January 13, 2011.

Currently, there are no other grants that require a legislative hearing.

The Budget Section and subsequently Legislative Management, recommends House Concurrent Resolution 3002 to authorize the Budget Section to hold public legislative hearings required for the receipt of new federal block grant funds during the period from the recess or adjournment of the 62nd Legislative Assembly through September 30, 2013.
