Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

Continue studying the impact of federal health care reform legislation on this state.

Minutes:

Chairman Keiser: Opens the hearing on HCR 3003.

John Bjorenson~Interim House Industry, Business and Labor Committee: I worked with the House Industry, Business and Labor Committee which studied the Health Care Reform. The beginning of the study was to see what is going to happen with the federal government, after March 23 let's see what the federal government did and what you have before you is a study resolution that would extend this study to keep monitoring the federal legislation. This would allow the interim committee to decipher the new rules that might come down and to provide recommendations to respond to that Federal Health Care Reform. I have an amendment proposed to change the last line to say instead of waiting to present the report to the 63rd Legislative Assembly it would also say if necessary report to a special reconvened session of the legislative assembly. This interim study could provide a recommendation for a consideration for a special session (see attached amendment).

Chairman Keiser: What is the power of a resolution?

John Bjorenson: A resolution is simply a statement to take a look at. Legislative management has the discretion as to which studies are chosen. Some are written to say "shall study", because those are in a bill they are mandatory studies. Typically they say shall consider study and so they become discretionary and legislative management has some authority to sort through the 100 or so proposed. There are so many that they can be done in an interim. A resolution is always a discretionary matter; it's a statement not a law like a bill is.

Al Carlson~Representative from District 41: There is another bill in that does establish the special session we are going to have. It will be in early November and it will deal with redistricting. It will establish the committee that will study between the end of the session and November how the states and districts will look for the next ten years. We did add on to that bill a statement that if the state needed to address issues of the federal health care reform legislation, that would be a topic that would be allow to be discussed during the special session. It is an important resolution.

Chairman Keiser: Is there anyone else here to testify in support, in opposition, neutral to HCR 3003? Closes the hearing.

Chairman Keiser: What are the wishes of the committee?

Vice Chairman Kasper: Moves to adopt the amendment.

Representative Kreun: Second.

Voice vote taken, motion carries.

Chairman Keiser: We have HCR 3003 as amended before us, what are the wishes of the committee?

Senator Judy Lee opened the hearing on HCR 3003.

There was no testimony in favor, opposing or neutral for HCR 3003.

The hearing was closed.

Committee discussion: Is there a need for this? This and HB 1252 overlap.

Senator Spencer Berry moved a **Do Not Pass**.

Seconded by **Senator Tim Mathern**.

Senator Dick Dever resisted the motion because it would be inconsistent with what he is supporting elsewhere.

Senator Tim Mathern said his concern is that the work has not been done yet on the other bill. He agrees that there is no need for this assuming the other bill passes.

Senator Judy Lee said this one is optional. The other is mandatory.

Senator Tim Mathern felt it should be mandatory and was willing to work on the other bill to make sure it addresses their needs. He supported the motion to defeat this one.

Senator Judy Lee didn't see the harm in passing both since they didn't seem to be in conflict with each other.

Discussion continued on being more focused on one or the other of the two bills.

Roll call vote on the Do Not Pass 1-4-0 – **Motion failed.**

Senator Gerald Uglem moved a **Do Pass**.
