Chairman DeKrey: We will open the hearing on HCR 3011.

Rep. Larry Klemin: Sponsor, support. HCR 3011 was drafted to continue a study that we've been doing in the Interim Judiciary Committee on a revised Uniform Limited Liability Company Act. During the last interim we looked at this Act and did not complete our study of the Act and consequently we'd like to continue that during the next Interim and that's all this bill does, is to ask us to continue that Study.

Chairman DeKrey: Thank you. Further testimony in support of HCR 3011.

Al Jaeger, Secretary of State: Support (see attached 1). We're grateful that it was laid over because we did have concerns in the last biennium with it. Some of those concerns may still exist in the upcoming biennium so the fact that it's a study because depending on how things shake out, we will be prepared for the next legislative session. I did pass out statistics. There are a lot more on here than limited liability companies, but I just wanted to point out that in the 1993 session was the first time that the limited liability company act was authorized. We've tweaked the law every session since then, but I do want to point out the number of limited liability companies that we have. The main concern that we have, in our office, is that whatever uniform law comes along doesn't jeopardize the thousands of limited liability companies that we have and so that's where the study comes in. It's going to be handy so we can make sure that they aren't impacted. Because you can see that we have quite a few. Clara just informed me that right now, in terms of registrations of LLCs are outpacing corporations about 2 to 1 in our office as far as new applications coming in. It's definitely a vehicle or business structure that the business community sees as a vital option for them. We support the study and we'll assist in that process, in whatever way we can.

Chairman DeKrey: Thank you. Further testimony in support of HCR 3011. Testimony in opposition. We will close the hearing.



Rep. Klemin – Says other states are waiting to act just like we are to see what states next to them are doing.

Senator Nething – Asked if they were influence because the president of the commission was a Minnesota lawyer.

Minnesota has not done anything with this yet. He said they have no problem with the study continuing. He says we have 15,000 limited liability companies and the number is exceeding corporations.
