Rep. Porter: We will open HCR 3039.

Rep. DeKrey: This resolution is to ask the powers of me to limit the overreach by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Whenever we do a grade raise in the wetland area that has an easement on it, even if we stay within the 66 feet of the imprint of the section line whatever water is displaced, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife is requiring that be replaced with a purchase of a wetland of somewhere else at \$10,500 per acre. The local share of any of those repairs was 15%. It is written in the work order that if you do a grade raise that is considered acreage loss and then the local energy has to replace that.

Rep. Nelson: To eminent domain how much would the land cost?

Rep. DeKrey: About \$600.00 an acre in our area. It is not \$10,500 an acre.

Rep. Nelson: The easement costs much more than the value of the land.

Rep. DeKrey: Yes way more.

Chairman Lyson opened the hearing on HCR 3039.

Representative Duane DeKrey, District 14, introduced the resolution. For the last 2 summers he worked the flood and he has been a gravel road inspector. When a grade raise is done FEMA forces townships and counties to buy land to replace the wetlands that they claim they are taking when they are raising the roads. He does not understand how it is causing a loss of wetland because the wetland is just moving out. The standard fee is \$10,500 per acre. If you are a township or a county that is doing a grade raise due to higher water and it happens to be in an area where they have an easement on either side of the road, when you raise the road and push that water out further, they are saying that there is a loss of a wetland and that you have to buy a wetland some other place in the state to make up for the taking of the wetland. I don't think that's right, and that is why I put this resolution in.

**Senator Triplett**: Is it both agencies that have these rules or is it one or the other that has these rules?

**Representative DeKrey**: They are both involved and I'm not sure if US Fish and Wildlife is telling FEMA to do it. It doesn't seem that FEMA would be doing it on their own.

Senator Triplett: As far as I know FEMA doesn't have any wetlands requirements.

**Representative DeKrey**: Of the \$10,500 per acre, 15% will go back onto the political subdivision that is raising the road. In the last two years there has been so much money spent on fixing the roads that the counties and townships are broke. Even though they can get 85% cost share from FEMA, they can't come up with the 15% to do it. Then they are required to go buy land somewhere at \$10,500 per acre.

Senator Freborg: Do you have any idea how much land are we talking about?

Representative Dekrey: I have no idea. I just have to identify if the road raise is in a wetland. FEMA searches out who has easements on that land. We are putting the grade raises within the 60' easement. I don't see how Fish and Wildlife has the authority to force a political subdivision to replace a wetland. The wetland may have been changed, but I don't see where there is a loss of wetland.

**Senator Triplett**: Have you had lines 10-12 looked at by the Attorney General as far as the authority issue?

Representative DeKrey: No, I didn't. In my opinion they are exceeding their authority.
