Chairman Klein, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Carlee McLeod, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer supports SB 2104 relating to collection of bank assessment fees.

The purpose of this bill is to provide consistency in the collection of fees.

With very few exceptions, most language in code relating to the collection or payment of fees provides that funds are to be deposited with the Office of the State Treasurer. A few sections of code are inconsistent with this model.

This bill provides that bank examination fees assessed by the Department of Financial Institutions be collected by DFI in the same manner that their other fees are collected. This change will allow for consistency for the Treasurer's Office, DFI, and the financial institutions that are currently responsible for paying a variety of fees to different places because of the existing inconsistencies.

Additionally, DFI is the agency with the relationship with the institutions. This bill allows financial institutions to continue to deal directly with DFI on the collection of these fees, as they already do for a variety of other issues.

Chairman Keiser, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Carlee McLeod, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer supports SB 2104 relating to collection of bank assessment fees.

The purpose of this bill is to provide consistency in the collection of fees.

With very few exceptions, most language in code relating to the collection or payment of fees rovides that funds are to be deposited with the Office of the State Treasurer. A few sections of code are inconsistent with this model.

This bill provides that bank examination fees assessed by the Department of Financial Institutions be collected by DFI in the same manner that their other fees are collected. This change will allow for consistency for the Treasurer's Office, DFI, and the financial institutions that are currently responsible for paying a variety of fees to different places because of the existing inconsistencies.

Additionally, DFI is the agency with the relationship with the institutions. This bill allows financial institutions to continue to deal directly with DFI on the collection of these fees, as they already do for a variety of other issues.

We have discussed this change with DFI, and we agree that this will provide a more efficient method to handle the fees.

Proposed amendment to Senate Bill 2104

Page 1, line 2, after the first semi-colon, insert "to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 13-04.1-44, relating to investigation and examination authority of money brokers;

Page 2, after line 3, insert the following:

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 13-4.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

13-04.1-11. Investigations and subpoenas.

- 1. The department of financial institutions in its discretion:
 - a. May make such public or private investigation within or outside this state as it deems necessary to determine whether any person has violated or is about to violate any provision of this chapter or any rule or order hereunder, or to aid in the enforcement of this chapter or in the prescribing of rules and forms hereunder. The licensee shall pay an investigation fee and must be charged by the department of financial institutions at an hourly rate to be set by the commissioner, sufficient to cover all reasonable expenses of the department associated with the visitation provided for by this section. Fees must be paid to the state treasurer and deposited in the financial institutions regulatory fund.
 - b. May require or permit any person to file a statement in writing, under oath or otherwise as the department determines, as to all the facts and circumstance concerning the matter to be investigated.
 - c. May publish information concerning any violation of this chapter or any rule or order hereunder.
