Chairman Nething, members of the Judiciary Committee, for the record my name is Richard Marcellais, Senator from District 9, of Belcourt I am here today to provide you with testimony on Senate Bill 2310 relating to reporting of certain travel expenses of members of the legislative assembly.

Senate Bill 2310 requires that legislative assembly who accept reimbursement or payment for travel expenses for attendance at a meeting or an event from a lobbyist or other person that is not an agency or entity of the state or a political subdivision shall submit a detailed report to the legislative council within thirty days after completing the travel. The report should include the following:

- a. Destination of Travel
- b. Purpose of Travel
- c. Amount of expense reimbursement or payment received including any actual travel and lodging expenses, meals and compensation.
- d. Name and address of the person providing reimbursement or payment

This does not apply to reimbursement or payment of travel expenses by a family member or to reimbursement or payment of travel expenses for a member of the legislative assembly for purposes that were related to the private business of the member or not directly related to public business.

Senate Bill 2310 is for accountability and responsibility to the citizens and taxpayers of North Dakota.
