Most of the time the disease is found in people ages 20-50 but there are a number of children who also get it. It is not normally considered to be a terminal illness but there are those who have died from complications. It is a chronic and disabling disease of the central nervous system and attacks the spinal column, the brain, and the optic nerves. Last year ND raised more than \$700,000 in attempts to find cures. There is a lot of research that is going on and in one case they are even doing some combined research

Senator Tim Mathern asked if this could be seen as a yearly event. In terms of the date, should it be a date for next year.

Sen. Carolyn Nelson thought it might be a date set by the National Association. It might not coincide exactly.

Sen. Carolyn Nelson: From District 21 Fargo sponsored and introduced the bill. I'm here to ask you to celebrate MS awareness week which started yesterday. I believe there is a luncheon tomorrow so you can meet some of the people involved with MS awareness. This is something we do every other year. We declare basically the second week of March to be MS awareness month. MS happens to have a higher prevalence the further you get away from the equator. In our part of the country there are quite a few people who have MS. It tends to be a later on set than some of the other diseases. We have run into a number of people who in the 20's and early 30's come down with the symptoms and then diagnosed. We raise a lot of money in ND for help in finding a cure. Last year it was close to \$700,000. These investments have worked out very well. One of the representatives of the pharmaceutical industry and said, you know we have this new drug and it is quite a change for many of the people who have MS that have to take injections. They get to the point where they just give up and they don't want to take those injections anymore. We have come up with a gel pill that is finding great acceptance and we are encouraged by how affective it is. That is what we are trying to do.
