Bismarck, January 5, 2011

The Senate convened at 12:30 p.m., with President Wrigley presiding.

The prayer was offered by Reverend LaRue Goetz, Revival Prayer Fellowship, Bismarck.

The roll was called and all members were present.

A quorum was declared by the President.

MOTION

SEN. CHRISTMANN MOVED that SB 2123 be returned to the Senate floor from the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee** and be rereferred to the **Judiciary Committee**, which motion prevailed.

MOTION

SEN. CHRISTMANN MOVED that SB 2125 be returned to the Senate floor from the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee** and be rereferred to the **Judiciary Committee**, which motion prevailed.

MOTION

SEN. CHRISTMANN MOVED that the Senate be on the Ninth order of business and at the conclusion of that order, the Senate stand in recess until 1:15 p.m., at which time it will meet in the House Chamber for a Joint Session, and after the Joint Session the Senate stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m., Thursday, January 6, 2011, which motion prevailed.

FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sen. Bowman and Rep. Drovdal introduced:

SB 2126: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact paragraph 6 of subdivision b of subsection 15 of section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of nonfarm income for purposes of the farm residence property tax exemption; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Lyson, Oehlke, Wardner and Rep. Onstad introduced:

SB 2127: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-10-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to ethanol dispensing unit labeling requirements.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Bowman, Erbele and Reps. Kempenich, Meyer introduced:

SB 2128: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 36-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to reimbursement for losses during official tuberculin testing of cattle; and to provide an appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Bowman, Lyson, Wardner, Warner and Reps. Meyer, Sukut introduced:

SB 2129: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 57-51-15 and 57-51.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to legacy fund deposits of oil and gas tax collections and holding political subdivisions harmless against allocation reductions; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Heckaman, Marcellais, Oehlke and Reps. Kelsch, D. Johnson, Vigesaa introduced:

SB 2130: A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for funding a director of Indian education.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Education Committee**.

Sens. Andrist, Nodland and Reps. Drovdal, Froseth, Onstad, Rust introduced:

SB 2131: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 47-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a surface access fee for oil and gas exploration and production.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

Sen. Nodland and Reps. Meyer, Schatz introduced:

SB 2132: A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce for a grant to the Dunn County fair association.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Appropriations Committee**.

Sens. Flakoll, Olafson, Schneider and Reps. Beadle, Maragos, Thoreson introduced:

SB 2133: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to using false identification to obtain alcoholic beverages.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Erbele, Christmann, Wanzek and Reps. Meyer, Pollert, Heller introduced:

SB 2134: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-08-02, 4.1-08-04, 4.1-08-06, and 4.1-08-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment on colonies of honeybees; to provide an appropriation; and to provide for a transfer.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Mathern, Heckaman, Taylor and Reps. Kaldor, Mock, Holman introduced:

SB 2135: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 6 of section 50-29-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the income eligibility limit for the children's health insurance program.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.

Sens. Lyson, Cook, Flakoll and Reps. Kasper, Kempenich, Ruby introduced:

SB 2136: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12-44.1-18.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to work release fees paid by offenders in a correctional facility.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Hogue, Oehlke, Heckaman and Reps. Brandenburg, Meyer, Porter introduced:

SB 2137: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-39.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a sales and use tax exemption for sales by thrift stores owned and operated by nonprofit corporations; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Hogue, Nodland, Larsen and Reps. Bellew, Damschen, Headland introduced:

SB 2138: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to employer's payment of accrued paid time off.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Industry, Business and Labor Committee**.

The Senate stood adjourned pursuant to Senator Christmann's motion.
