FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sens. Olafson, Fischer, Heckaman and Reps. R. Kelsch, Boehning, Wieland introduced:

SB 2187: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-23.3-02, 43-23.3-03, and 43-23.3-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the North Dakota real estate appraiser qualifications and ethics board and appraiser permit approval standards; and to provide for application.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee**.

Sens. G. Lee, Oehlke, Wanzek and Reps. Ruby, N. Johnson, Delmore introduced:

SB 2188: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 39-05-02.2 and 39-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to exclusions from the certificate of title requirement for vehicles regularly engaged in interstate transportation of persons or property.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sen. Kilzer and Rep. Klemin introduced:

SB 2189: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 9 of section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the acreage of church property eligible for the church property tax exemption; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Nething, Lyson and Reps. DeKrey, Kretschmar introduced:

SB 2190: A BILL for an Act to create a new subsection to section 54-23.3-04 of the North

Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers and duties of the director of the department of corrections and rehabilitation; and to amend and reenact section 12-59-20 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to probation and parole officers.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Andrist, Lyson, Wardner and Reps. Devlin, Dosch, Froseth introduced:

SB 2191: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-01-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to publication of park district board proceedings.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Political Subdivisions Committee**.

Sens. J. Lee, Dever, Heckaman and Reps. Devlin, Holman, Weisz introduced:

SB 2192: A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 27-20-30.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the disposition of a child needing continued foster care services after the age of eighteen and under the age of twenty-one; to amend and reenact sections 27-20-03, 27-20-11, 27-20-21, 27-20-22, 27-20-26, 27-20-32.2, and 27-20-36 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to jurisdiction, venue, contents of petition, summons, right to counsel, reasonable efforts to prevent removal or to unify, and limitations of time on orders of disposition; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.

Sens. Nodland, Dotzenrod, Murphy and Reps. Kasper, Schatz introduced:

SB 2193: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 40-51.2-05 and 40-51.2-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to notice of proposed annexations.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Triplett, Nelson, Erbele, Warner and Reps. Kingsbury, Schmidt introduced:

SB 2194: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to designation of "Dancing Dakota", written and composed by Chuck Suchy, as the official North Dakota waltz; and to amend and reenact section 54-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the official state hymn.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Olafson, Lyson, Schneider and Reps. Delmore, N. Johnson, Maragos introduced:

SB 2195: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 47-16-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to remedies for termination of a lease due to domestic violence.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Wardner, Christmann, Lyson and Reps. Brandenburg, DeKrey, Porter introduced:

SB 2196: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 49-22-03 and subsection 1 of section 49-22-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of energy conversion facility and to siting application fees.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

Sens. Wardner, Robinson, Krebsbach and Reps. Kempenich, Monson, Williams introduced:

SB 2197: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-43.2-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to licensing requirements for the special fuels tax; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Grindberg, Larsen, Robinson and Reps. Beadle, Keiser, Metcalf introduced:

SB 2198: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-21.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning interoperability standards; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Political Subdivisions Committee**.

Sens. G. Lee, Berry, Fischer and Reps. Grande, Hawken, Streyle introduced:

SB 2199: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 and a new section to chapter 43-42 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal history record checks for individuals licensed by the state board of respiratory care.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sen. Erbele and Reps. Brandenburg, Kretschmar introduced:

SB 2200: A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of transportation for a grant for the Cattail Bay road improvement project.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Appropriations Committee**.

Sens. Miller, Sitte and Reps. Weiler, Wrangham introduced:

SB 2201: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 14-09-00.1 and 14-09-29 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to parenting rights and responsibilities; to provide for retroactive application; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.

The Senate stood adjourned pursuant to Senator Klein's motion.
