  - c. The dispensing veterinarian verifies the prescription with the prescribing veterinarian."

- 6.7. "Oil and gas development" means the exploration for and production of oil and gas and industries directly relating to the refining or processing of the oil or gas.
- 7.8. "Taxing district" means any political subdivision, other than those included in subsections 2 through 45, empowered by law to levy taxes."
