
Dear Council Members:

In response to your questions:

1. The rules did not result from statutory changes made by the Legislative Assembly.
2. The rules are not related to any federal statute or regulation.
3. The Board followed the rulemaking procedure published by the North Dakota Legislative Council. Public notice was posted in all ND newspapers via the ND Newspaper Association, and also posted on the Board's web site. One public hearing was held.
4. No oral comment was received. One written comment was received from Greg Welch of Aberdeen Area Indian Health Service. The Board considered the comment at a Board Meeting and moved to take no action as a result of the comment.
5. The approximate cost is \$1650.
6. The Board adopted Admin. Rule 96-02-10-01 to add 'Antibodies to the human immunodeficiency virus types 1 and 2 by Clearview complete HIV1/2 assay' as a waived test to be performed by non-licensed personnel supervised by personnel licensed under the North Dakota Board of Clinical Laboratory Practice.
7. No regulatory analysis was required.
8. No regulatory analysis or economic impact statement of impact on small entities was required.
9. No fiscal effect.
10. No takings assessment was prepared.
11. Rules were not adopted as emergency rules.
