Code § 89-03-03-02 regarding the definition of domestic rural use. ARTICLE 89-03 WATER APPROPRIATIONS

CHAPTER 89-03-03 DEFINITIONS

Section 89-03-03-02 is amended as follows:

89-03-03-02. Definition of domestic rural use. For the purpose of North Dakota Century Code section 61-04-01.1, "domestic rural use" means two or more family units or households obtaining water from the same system for personal needs and for household purposes, including heating, drinking, washing, sanitary, and culinary uses; irrigation of land not exceeding five acres [2.0 hectares] in area for each family unit or household for noncommercial gardens, orchards, lawns, trees, or shrubbery; and for household pets and domestic animals kept for household sustenance and not for sale or commercial use.
