The tobacco companies withheld over \$700 million due under the Master Settlement Agreement (MSA) alleging the states did not diligently enforce their statutes. Over \$2,600,000 of that amount			

Supreme Court held the issue whether North Dakota diligently enforced its statute must be resolved in a multi-state arbitration.

Preliminary hearings have been held in the multi-state arbitration. A two-week common case hearing (a hearing presenting evidence on behalf of all of the states) will be held in April, 2012. Two-week hearings will be held almost every month thereafter through June 2013. The hearing involving North Dakota will be held in October. The hearings will be held in various locations, including Chicago, Illinois, Fort Myers, Florida, and others yet to be decided. The location for the October hearing has not been decided. It is unknown at this time whether funding will be needed in the 2013-15 biennium budget.

In addition to the costs of counsel attending the various hearings, there will be costs associated with the common case hearing and the North Dakota state specific hearing, including facility costs, costs for court reporters, and the fees of the arbitration panel, which consists of three retired federal judges. There will also be costs associated with preparing for and presenting evidence at the hearings, including costs associated with witness and expert witness travel, expert witness fees, etc.

The states have a cost sharing agreement to share costs incurred for the benefit of all states. North Dakota will need to pay a portion of the shared costs and its own costs. This is the first request for funding needed to address tobacco diligent enforcement and the associated revenues due to the state.
