NDDOT has been awarded a TIGER III grant of \$10 million from the U.S. Dept. of Transportation. The grant will be used in conjunction with funding provided by Amtrak and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad to rebuild a 20-mile segment of track and two bridges near Churchs Ferry, N.D. The track, which was closed several times last spring because of flooding, is used by BNSF and Amtrak Empire Builder trains.			
NDDOT requests the grants appropriation line be increased \$10 million to allow the NDDOT to accept and expend the \$10 million federal grant.
