NDDOT has been awarded \$344,700,000 by the Federal Highway Administration for emergency repairs to state and local highways throughout the state. The \$344.7 million consists of \$316.79 million of 2011 Federal Emergency Relief (ER) Funding and \$27.91 million of 2010 Federal ER funding.

The federal funds will require state matching funds of \$45.6 million. The matching funds will be borrowed from the Bank of ND pursuant to Section 4 of HB1012 (2011 legislative session) and Section 5 of SB2371 (2011 special legislative session). The appropriation authority for the state matching funds has already been provided in those legislative bills, therefore it is not included in this emergency commission request. The federal funding will also require \$32.4 million of local match, which is included in this request.

NDDOT requests an increase of \$377,100,000 (\$344.7 million federal funds+\$32.4 million local match) to the operating expenditure (\$64,670,000), capital asset (\$269,730,000) and grants (\$42,700,000 million) appropriation lines to enable the department to accept and expend the federal emergency relief funds and the related local match.
