Special Nutrition Programs Farm to School Grant Program	1-2 years	51,241
Purpose of Grant: The purpose of the North Dakota Farm to School project is to coordinate and accelerate the diffusion of activities across our state from a few dedicated schools and producers to a more widely accepted and utilized way to provide food for schools and other institutions. North Dakota's project will focus on three audiences. The focus for foodservice personnel is help to increase their readiness to accept locally-grown food and their capacity to utilize local products. For producers, the focus is to continue the training of producers in Good Agricultural Practices and packaging/selling techniques. To connect producers with schools, pilot schools and producers will develop a model process to determine quantities needed to produce and order, order specification, pricing and bidding. To help students and families accept, appreciate and eat more locally-produced foods, nutrition education will be provided in classrooms and the lunchroom. To increase awareness of farm to school efforts statewide, web-based and other social media will help tell the story of those schools and producers who have taken early roles and are successfully serving North Dakota products in their cafeterias. A dedicated Farm to School website will be created for connecting schools and producers, housing resources and sharing success stories broadly with the public.


