

Senator Carolyn C. Nelson was elected president of the National Federation of Music Clubs at McLean, Virginia, last month. Senator Nelson became the 32nd president of the National Federation of Music Clubs and the second president from North Dakota. The National Federation of Music Clubs is the largest philanthropic musical organization in the world. The federation has the distinction of being chartered by the Congress of the United States. Senator Nelson represents District 21 in the Legislative Assembly--serving as a representative in 1987 and 1993 and as a senator since 1995.
