- April of even number years ITD establishes rates for the upcoming biennium.
- ITD meets with OMB, Legislative Council staff and agencies to highlight rate changes.
- Very difficult to increase rates once an agency receives it's budget.
- ITD is Mostly Special Funded Costs to provide most information technology services are recovered by billing the agencies who use them.

ITD Service Rates 2013-15 Biennium


Funding source of agency money paid to ITD is approximately:


1/3 general funds,

Network & Telephone Services - \$ 700,090


