- a. Replace SBHE with an elected Commissioner of Higher Education
- b. Commissioner would control only higher ed (not K-12)
- c. Commissioner would have broad authority to manage the ND university system, and all institutions of higher education, including:
 - i. Hiring and firing presidents thereof
 - ii. Submitting a budget for consideration by the ND Legislature, who shall exercise independent authority and control of appropriations for the university system
- d. Term of 6 years; maximum of 2 terms.
- e. Free to hire a deputy, or other assistance as authorized by law.
- f. Removable as any other elected official

3. How do we bring about this reform?

- a. Initiated Measure to the state constitution
- b. Concurrent Resolution
- c. Either way, we have a responsibility to reform
