Key Issues

- A robust high speed data communications network is vital for the State and the North Dakota University System
- In the 2007 Legislative Session the University System was granted authority to manage and regulate information technology planning and services for institutions under its control. (NDCC 15-10-44)

Key Issues

- System Information Technology Services is funded as an entity.
- Microsoft Campus agreement (\$43 per FTE)
- Collaboration Software
- Consolidate email and establish system wide authentication

Key Issues

- Ensure Institutions have adequate Bandwidth
- ConnectND, Student, Finance, HR, parking, housing
- Library System and Databases
- Mobile Applications
- Lecture and Content Capture

Key Issues

- Two-way video support/HD
- Help Desk Services 24x7x365
- ??????

Current Challenges

- Planning and funding of the Joint IT Facility
- Merging core technology service areas at UND into SITS
- Hardware and Software maintenance charges
- Continuing efforts to improve the quality and accuracy of data.

Key Needs

- Funding support to cover inflationary increase in operations associated primarily with hardware and software maintenance.
- Support for new operational costs associated with the Joint IT facility.
- Data Analysts for Policy Analysis
