#### Introduction

In 1987, the North Dakota legislature established the Health Care Data Committee as a standing committee of the State Health Council. Under North Dakota Century Code § 23-01.1, the Health Care Data Committee is authorized to prepare an annual report that compares average hospital charges for the twenty-five most common diagnoses treated in nonfederal, acute care hospitals in North Dakota. In accordance with that legislative mandate, this report contains baseline information for comparing average hospital charges and lengths of stay for the twenty-five most frequent diagnoses treated in North Dakota hospitals.

However, it is important to recognize that comparing charges is only one way of evaluating hospitals in North Dakota. While this report provides comparative information on hospital charges for similar illnesses, there are other important measures that should be considered. These include the quality of care provided, the intensity and specialization of services offered, and the severity of cases treated.

#### **DRGs**

The comparative charge information presented in this report shows the average charges and average length of stay (LOS) by "diagnosis related group" (DRG). A DRG is one of 495 classifications of diagnoses in which people with similar conditions use similar amounts of health care resources. DRGs are used here for grouping similar types of claims; for example, normal newborns (DRG 391), Cesarean section without complicating conditions (DRG 371), and coronary bypass with cardiac catheterization (DRG 106).

#### How the Information was Compiled

The health care data act authorizes the Committee to require insurers, nonprofit health service corporations, health maintenance organizations, and state agencies to provide data. Under this authority the Health Care Data Committee requested diagnosis-specific health insurance claims data, using a standard minimum data set derived from the federal UB-82 claim form, from the five accident and health insurance companies doing the most business in North Dakota for calendar year 1993. In addition, the Committee obtained the calendar year 1993 Medicare and Medicaid inpatient hospital claims for North Dakota. These claim files were combined into a single inpatient hospital claims data set.

From this data set the records that met all the applicable data processing criteria (i.e., records that were complete, groupable to DRGs, and applied to North Dakota

inpatient, nonfederal, acute care facilities) were extracted and grouped according to the diagnosis related groups. This data set contains 62,723 records, about 70 percent of all North Dakota acute care hospitalizations during 1993.

Next, the Medicare criteria for length of stay and cost outliers were applied to the data to remove the records that reflected an unusually high cost or long hospital stay. This data was then used to calculate the average charge information provided in this report.

The hospitals are listed in two categories. Large hospitals have one hundred or more licensed beds. Small hospitals have less than one hundred licensed beds. For each of these categories the statewide average charge per case and length of stay are listed for each DRG. The hospitals are listed in <u>descending</u> order of their average charges for that DRG. The first column to the right of the hospital name/location is headed "Total Cases." This represents the total number of cases used in calculating the average length of stay and average charge per case. In those instances where the total number of cases for a DRG and for a hospital was less than five, the data is not reported because the Committee felt that a meaningful average could not be calculated on the basis of fewer than five cases.

#### Considerations in Using the Data

Differences in practice patterns, the severity of cases treated, and the quality of care delivered can affect the cost of care and the length of stay in North Dakota hospitals. This report should be examined with these considerations in mind.

It is also important to remember that:

- Average The data reported are based on averages. This means any particular case may differ from the average charge and the average length of stay.
- Charges The data in this report are average "charges" for a particular diagnosis at each hospital. These charges do not reflect the actual payment to hospitals after reductions for discounts, charity care or "fixed" payments made by government or by private insurance claims payment programs. Further, charges do not reflect the actual cost to the hospital for providing the service.
- Average Length of Stay The data reported are based on the number of days
  of care received by each patient discharged during the period covered by the
  report. Patients admitted and discharged from the hospital in the same day
  were excluded from the calculation; overnight stays in the hospital were
  counted as one day.

- Hospital Charges The charges reported include only hospital charges, not charges for physician services or other services which are billed separately.
- Seriousness or Severity of Illness The severity of illness varies from one
  patient to another within the DRG categories. The DRGs presented in this
  report do not fully account for differences in severity of illness or intensity
  of treatments. They are intended only to represent, for comparative
  purposes, the average charge for patients in a DRG.

While the information in this report does not reflect the severity of illnesses treated in North Dakota hospitals, a case-mix index for North Dakota (Appendix B) shows some variability in the severity of illness and intensity of treatments in North Dakota hospitals. A case-mix index is a method of adjustment used to reflect the severity of illness and complexity of treatment for patients at a particular hospital. It is intended to reflect the relative resource consumption associated with patients treated at a hospital. The higher the index, the greater the average resource consumption per patient. It is presented in Appendix A to give a general measure of the relative severity of cases treated in North Dakota hospitals.

#### Hospital Comments

Because a wide variety of factors, in addition to those discussed in this introduction, may affect hospital charges, the Health Care Data Committee invited each hospital to comment on the information contained in this report. The comments of those who chose to respond are contained in Appendix A.

St. Alexius Medical Center has reviewed your "Guide to Hospital Charges by Diagnosis Related Group for 1994." We continue to support efforts to try to develop meaningful public information regarding healthcare delivery. Your rules require that each provider identified in the report be allowed 30 days to review and comment on the data. Please accept this letter as our response to the information contained in its entirety in the appendix to the report.

Under NDCC 23-01.1, the Health Care Data Committee is directed to provide information comparing the cost of hospitalization, by diagnosis, in each nonfederal, acute care hospital in North Dakota. The report continues to use gross average charge as its measurement. Since the inception of the Federal Prospective Payment System in 1984, and the State Medicaid DRG System in 1986, the healthcare provider has by regulation been assigned its cost by DRG via the DRG payment process. For each DRG category, the amount we paid is fixed by law and has no direct relationship to a gross average charge comparison. With Blue Cross instituting a DRG system in 1987, their inpatient payment is now also not directly related to gross charges. If Champus DRG's, Indian Health DRG's, and/or other capitated programs are DRG's included. approximately 80% of our payment for services has no relationship to gross charge. Therefore, to continue to evidence "gross average charges" as a way of evaluating hospital services is not an accurate accounting of healthcare reimbursement. Other factors such as quality of care, intensity of service, and physician choice should be taken into consideration before health care choices are made.

Secondly, the healthcare industry continues to experiment with a way to uniformly measure intensity of service and treatment outcomes. Although states such as Pennsylvania and Colorado have attempted to measure severity, no one system has been adopted by J.C.A.H.O. or H.C.F.A. that allows hospitals to uniformly measure acuity. Your report states a key factor that the DRG's, as they

are used in the report, do not fully account for differences in severity of illness or intensity of treatment. Differences in practice patterns, the relative severity of the cases treated, and the quality of care delivered have an effect on the charge for care rendered. Until an industry standard of measurement, like APR-DRG's, is adopted for acuity, DRG average charges continue to be a limited way to provide information to the public regarding healthcare choices.

Thirdly, the report continues to be unable to capture 100% of the cases serviced by each facility in the top (25) DRG's. Also the report is unable to show what percentage to total cases within each DRG are being compared.

Fourthly, because of the structure of DRG's and their reliance on averages, caution must be used in comparing data on the "average" or "typical" patient. Most DRG's cover multiple different acuity service codes within a DRG. Therefore, if you treat a more acute code within the DRG, it is reasonable that length of stay and charges will be higher. Although the committee has attempted to remove the atypical patient from the report, the variation of coding within DRG's makes this very difficult. The attempt points out the continued problem of having no reliable or agreed upon acuity adjustment in the DRG system.

Finally, the report makes no attempt to group facilities by case mix index or level of services provided. Technology and specialization are definite factors in comparing facilities.

As in past years, St. Alexius Medical Center continues to recognize and support the need to make our publics more aware of costs. But in publishing comparisons based on the average charge by DRG, we continue to emphasize that the public has only a limited portion of the data needed to make an informed healthcare choice.

In response to the North Dakota Department of Health 1994 Guide to Hospital Charges by diagnoses related groups dated November 21, 1995, I would like to point out several points relating to DRG 389, full term neonate with major problems, DRG 390 neonate with other significant problems, and DRG 391 normal newborn. In your document you list MeritCare Hospital in Fargo as being the highest charge per case for large hospitals for DRG 389 and 390, but failed to take into account a significant case mix difference in other hospitals.

According to my calculations, the following table represents total number of admissions per DRG category and total term newborns and the estimated percentage of term newborns that were described as "ill". It is fairly obvious that there has been a misreporting of classification of DRG diagnoses in the draft report. It would seem that St. Alexius Medical Center has a 66% illness rate in its term population and Med Center One has a 39.6% illness rate in its population of term newborns. St. Alexius ranked 4 times higher than most other hospitals in the state and would seem to indicate a significant deviation from accepted rates of illness for term newborns.

Upon calculating the average charge per case for all term infants in hospitals with board certified or eligible neonatologists, MeritCare Hospitals charges \$1027, Trinity Hospitals \$1180, Med Center One \$1289 and St. Alexius \$1669. It is of note that hospitals without neonatologists refer their extremely ill infants to hospitals with neonatologists. This factor would slightly skew numbers towards increased cost for referral centers.

In order to accurately report the average charge per case for term infants, the charges should be reported in a different manner than is being utilized in the current report.

It is imperative that healthcare providers around the state be aware of such large discrepancies in numbers or percentages of infants described as "ill" when reported by an official agency such as the North Dakota Health Care Data Committee.

I have had the opportunity to review the information presented in your "1994 Guide to Hospital Charges by Diagnosis Related Group". I am concerned that the information presented is not relevant to the people of North Dakota. As those of us in the health care industry know, charges, due to the way that payment is now given to medical providers, is irrelevant. You can charge low or charge high, but the amount of money that you actually receive from third party payers is fixed. Therefore, as an example, on DRG 88 it appears that St. Alexius Medical Center charges are higher than any other large hospital in the state. Yet, St. Alexius and all other hospitals do not get paid by what they charge. Instead, they are paid according to the fixed payment that is determined by third party payers and/or the federal government. Hence, the "average charge per case" is a meaningless number. As is also noted, on DRG 88 and some of the other respiratory DRG's, there is exclusions for atypical cases. What is not included is that the "average case" is unable to be compared to an "average case" of another medical center. As I am sure you are well aware, St. Alexius Medical Center is the main referral center for individuals who have difficult cases regarding respiratory medicine. This is evidenced by the number of atypical cases that show up in the atypical case count. Yes, severity is taken into account once something is considered "atypical", however, having worked at both the St. Alexius Medical Center and MedCenter One, the types of patients that are seen are completely different. Yes, I agree that there are individuals at other medical centers that have very difficult COPD. However, my four years of experience at MedCenter One, leads me to realize that individuals with COPD there are in no way as ill as the individuals who are seen by St. Alexius Medical Center and the Heart and Lung Clinic. Therefore, as one compares the average length of stay in days, these numbers are not "apples and apples" due to the fact of the severity of individuals who are using the St. Alexius Medical Center for their respiratory health care needs.

My suggestion is as follows: if this information is important to the North Dakota citizens, that some type of severity index be implemented so that you truly are comparing "apples and apples". Also, the "average charges per case" is a misleading number, which leads people to look at this data and state that they would choose one health care provider over the other because they are providing less charges to them. In essence, the cost to the patient is relatively fixed as most third party payers require medical center's to accept whatever payment they provide.

I realize that you, too, may understand that this information is somewhat irrelevant, however, please let us not simply continue doing something because "it's in the law" when in essence, our tax dollars can be utilized in other ways that would benefit the citizens of North Dakota in a more appropriate way.

Obviously, you are probably receiving responses from other health care institutions from across the state, and I am sure that many of them are reiterating my points also. I hope that you will work diligently to most effectively utilize the monies that the tax payers of North Dakota have entrusted you with to provide them with the maximum benefit that they deserve.

#### INTRODUCTION

With the passage of NDCC 23-01.1 in 1987, the North Dakota legislature established the Health Care Data Committee as a standing committee of the North Dakota State Health Council. As stated in the law, the duties of the Committee are to provide the public with the information necessary for the enhancement of price competition in the health care market. More specifically, the law states that the Health Care Data Committee is to prepare an annual report comparing the cost of hospitalization, by diagnosis, in each nonfederal, acute care hospital in North Dakota. In accordance with the Health Care Data Committee's legislative mandate, this report is intended to encourage competition in the health care industry by providing individual and institutional health care purchasers with baseline information against which they can compare hospital charges.

Comparing prices is one way of evaluating competing hospital services. This report provides comparative information on what hospitals charge for similar illnesses. There are other measures of hospitals' services that should be taken into consideration; for example, quality of care and technological intensity of the services.

#### **DRGs**

The comparative price information presented here shows average charges and average length of stay by DRG. DRGs are the diagnosis related groups established by the federal government and used in paying for the hospitalization of Medicare enrollees. Very few hospitals actually bill by DRG, but these diagnosis related groups are useful measures for comparing hospital charges because they are understandable and comparable. Actual hospital charges are in most cases for detailed services that, to the lay person, have no direct relationship to the kind of illness or surgery for which they are hospitalized. DRGs are used by Medicare and Medicaid to determine, in advance of the delivery of hospital services, a payment appropriate for a given patient's condition.

In the DRGs, similar conditions that cost about the same to treat are grouped together. This guide lists the common English names of some of the conditions that are included in each DRG. Further information about how cases are grouped to form the DRGs is included in Appendix B.

#### How the Information was Compiled

The health care data act authorizes the Committee to require insurers, nonprofit health service corporations, health maintenance organizations, and state agencies to provide data. Under this authority the Health Care Data Committee requested diagnosis-specific health insurance claims data, using a standard minimum data set derived from the federal UB-82 claim form, from the seven largest accident and health insurance companies doing business in North Dakota for calendar year 1992. In addition, the Committee obtained copies on magnetic tape of the calendar year 1992 Medicare and Medicaid hospitalization claims experience for North Dakota. These claim files were combined into a single North Dakota hospitalization claim data set.

From this data set the records that met all the applicable data processing criteria (i.e., records that were complete, groupable to DRGs, and applied to North Dakota inpatient, nonfederal, acute care facilities) were extracted and grouped according to the Medicare diagnosis related groups. This data set contains 63,325 records, about 73% of all North Dakota acute care hospitalizations during 1992.

Next, the Medicare criteria for length of stay outliers were applied to the data to remove the records that reflected an unusually long length of stay. Further, the claims that exceeded the larger of \$12,000 or 1.5 times the average charge for the DRG were considered atypical and were excluded from the calculations. The remaining hospitalization claim records were considered to reflect typical hospitalizations for that diagnosis related group. This data was then used to calculate the average charge information provided in this report.

Table I lists the twenty-five most common DRGs reported to insurers in North Dakota in 1992. The report displays information for hospitals with five or more cases. The twenty-five most common DRGs represent forty-six percent of the 1992 hospital claims database.

The hospitals are listed in two categories. Large hospitals have one hundred or more licensed beds. Small hospitals have less than one hundred licensed beds. For each of these categories the statewide average charge per case and length of stay are listed for each DRG. Following the statewide average charge and length of stay, the hospitals are listed in descending order of their average charges for that DRG. The first column to the right of the hospital name/location is headed "Total Cases." This represents the total number of normal cases used in calculating the average length of stay and average charge per case. In those instances where the total number of normal cases for that DRG and for a hospital was less than five, the data was not reported. This information was suppressed in the report partly because of concerns about patient confidentiality and partly because the Committee felt that a meaningful average could not be calculated on

the basis of fewer than five cases. For each hospital with five or more normal cases, the average length of stay and average charge per case are reported. Charges for patients classified within the same DRG will vary from the average charge reported here depending on the intensity of care, length of stay and/or the use of special services. The DRGs, as they are used here, do not fully account for differences in severity of illness or intensity of treatment. They are intended only to represent, for comparative purposes, the average charge experience of a typical patient in that DRG.

#### Considerations in Using the Data

Differences in practice patterns, the relative severity of the cases treated, and diferences in the quality of care delivered can all have an effect on the cost of care. This report should be examined with these considerations in mind.

- o Average The data reported here are averages. Individual cases differ; charges and lengths of stay will vary from one case to another.
- o Charges, Not Costs or Payments The charge data presented here are based on the amount each hospital charged the typical hospital patient before reductions for negotiated discounts, bad debt, and charity care. These charges <u>do not</u> show what the provision of care cost the hospital or what the hospital actually received in payment.
- o Average Length of Stay This figure is based on the number of days of care received by each patient discharged during the period covered by the report. Patients admitted and discharged from the hospital in the same day are excluded from the calculation; overnight stays in the hospital were counted as one day.
- o Hospital Charges The charges reported here include only hospital charges, not charges for physician services which are billed directly by the physician.
- o Seriousness or Severity of Illness Severity of illness varies from one patient to another within the DRG categories. The DRGs were developed and are intended to measure only the average amount of resources used in treating an average case of that type. The severity of an individual patient's illness can affect the charges for treating any individual case. However, since atypical cases have been excluded, this variability within the averages reported here has been limited. The number of atypical cases reported for each hospital is an indication of how many cases fell into the higher cost and/or longer stay category. A high number of atypical cases may indicate

that the hospital treats a large number of very ill patients. It also indicates that a large number of patients were charged at least fifty percent more than the average reported here, or that a high number of patients experienced a longer length of stay.

Objective analytical methods for measuring the severity of an individual patient's illness upon entering the hospital are currently being developed. This report does not attempt to make any finer distinction on the basis of severity of illness within the DRGs (see Appendix B).

#### **Hospital Comments**

Appendix A of this report contains comments submitted by North Dakota hospitals regarding the data published here. A wide variety of factors, in addition to those discussed in this introduction, may affect hospital charges. In order to provide the reader with this additional information, the Health Care Data Committee invited each hospital to comment on the information to be contained in this report. The comments of those who chose to respond are contained in Appendix A.

## **APPENDICES**

#### INTRODUCTION TO APPENDICES

The following two appendices are intended to provide the reader with additional information for use in considering the average charge and average length of stay data contained in this report.

Appendix A contains the comments submitted for publication in the report by individual hospitals. The Health Care Data Committee provided a draft copy of <u>A Guide to Hospital Charges by Diagnosis Related Group</u> to each North Dakota facility. The hospitals were asked to comment on the material contained in the introduction to the draft report and to verify that the data contained in the draft report accurately reflected their charges for these DRGs.

Appendix B provides an explanation of the logic used to group individual cases into diagnosis related groups. The DRG methodology is intended to produce groupings that are clinically meaningful; that is, the cases within a given DRG should cost about the same amount of money to treat.

#### Classification of Cases into DRGs

The case classification system groups together cases that require similar amounts of hospital resources. While several different classification systems have been developed, the most commonly accepted and utilized approach is the diagnosis related group (DRG) system. This classification method, originally developed by researchers at Yale University for utilization review and internal audit purposes, assigns cases to one of 490 different groups. It has also been applied by the Medicare program and several state Medicaid programs for their hospital payment systems.

DRGs were not created only from statistical analysis. A great deal of medical judgment was also used to determine the distinctions that make medical sense. These combinations were verified statistically and physicians used statistics to augment their medical judgment. This combination of medical judgment and empirical work is unique to the DRG system and is one reason it is so widely accepted.

A form of "decision tree" logic is used to assign cases to specific DRGs. That is, a series of questions are asked about a particular patient and the sequence of answers determines the DRG to which that case is assigned. The questions focus on the aspects of a patient's condition that research has found to be related to the amount of hospital resources required to care for the patient. These include:

- 1. Major body system affected.
- Whether or not surgery was performed.
- 3. Principal diagnosis.
- Age of patient.
- 5. Any secondary conditions.
- Discharge status.

Once a patient is discharged from a hospital, the case can be assigned to a DRG. A computer program, known as Grouper, assigns cases to individual DRGs using standard information called the UB-82 hospital discharge data set. (In 1985, North Dakota adopted the Medicare UB-82 billing form as the "Uniform Proof of Loss" form for all health insurers. That means that all insurance companies must accept the standardized UB-82 form as a claim form for hospital insurance purposes.)

The first thing the DRG Grouper program needs to know is the general nature of the problem. That is, was this patient admitted to treat a circulatory system problem, a respiratory system problem, a pregnancy, or a mental disease? There are twenty-three general problem types, called major diagnostic categories (MDCs). The MDCs generally match the medical specialties of physicians (see Table A-1). This makes the DRGs more useful as a management tool for hospitals and helps the state's utilization review program to analyze individual physician practice patterns. Physicians are, after all, responsible for resource-use decisions in hospitals.

To better understand how DRGs classify patients, consider a patient admitted for treatment of a respiratory system problem. This case would be classified as illustrated in Figure A-First, this case will be assigned to category MDC 04, "Diseases and Disorders of the Respiratory System."

The Yale researchers found that, in general, the most important determinant of th resources required to treat a case is whether a major operating room procedure wa performed. Therefore, the first thing the program will want to know is whether such surgical procedure was done. Most major diagnostic categories are divided into medica and surgical parts in this way. (The full DRG decision tree for one MDC, prepared by Yal University, is presented in Figures A-2 and A-3. Figure A-1 is easier to follow because th questions are made explicit.)

If a major operating room procedure was <u>not</u> done during this admission, the specific typof respiratory problem is most useful in distinguishing whether a case will require more of less intensive treatment. A typical lung cancer admission will cost more to treat that pneumonia, so the next thing that the Grouper program asks for is the principal diagnosis for this case. The cancer case will fall under DRG 82, "Respiratory Neoplasms."

If, instead, this admission was to treat simple pneumonia, the Grouper would need more information. For pneumonia, children's cases require different resources than adult cases so the Grouper asks whether the person was less than eighteen years old. A child's admission would be classified as DRG 91. For adults, Grouper needs still more information to categorize the case. The UB-82 data set allows multiple diagnoses for a single patient such as lung cancer or pneumonia complicated by heart disease. For adults, such a complicating condition (also called a secondary diagnosis) may make that case more difficult and more expensive to treat. That is, the patient with a certain secondary diagnosis listed on the billing form is probably more severely ill. Therefore, Grouper asks whether the patient has any of a list of specific complicating conditions. If so, the case is classified as DRG 89, "Simple Pneumonia with Complicating Conditions." Uncomplicated adult pneumonia cases are classified as DRG 90.


As this example shows, the steps in classifying a particular case can vary. However, the underlying logic is always the same. The first split is always the most important. Less important distinctions occur later in the decision tree. In our example, surgery was the firs and most important variable. However, for a pregnancy the most critical question is whethe the admission actually resulted in a delivery. This separates admissions for false labor from the deliveries.



## FIGURE A-1 AN EXAMPLE OF DRG LOGIC




