

K-12 IT Initiatives

Distance Delivery of ND High School Courses

- ITV Consortia – courses via video
 - 135 ND schools - 234 courses
 - 3,384 students - 37% increase since 2009
- ND Center for Distance Education - courses online
 - 115 ND schools
 - 806 ND students – 38% increase since 2010
 - 5 ND schools, 17 classes – whole class instruction
 - Renewed focus on ND students – small schools

K-12 IT Initiatives

- ND ETC Video Grants Budget - \$255,000
- RUS Grant through USDA Rural Development
 - Goal: Replace 49 end-of-service video codecs in ND K-12 video classrooms
 - Grant application submitted in April 2011
 - Grant awarded December 2011: \$392,000
 - Grant funds will be matched by ETC video grant funds and ITD video upgrade budget: \$156,000

K-12 IT Initiatives

- PowerSchool Update
 - PowerSchool student information system in all ND public schools by July 2013.
 - 23 new schools using PowerSchool fall 2011.
 - 7 more will go live this semester.
 - 7 more will go live fall 2012.
 - Final 11 schools will be on PowerSchool during second semester 2012-13.

K-12 IT Initiatives

- E-Rate
 - Federal program buys down the cost of network connectivity for K-12 schools and libraries.
 - ND K-12 STAGEnet funded 65% by E-Rate.
 - \$3.1 million this fiscal year.
 - ND K-12 schools apply for additional E-Rate discounts to cover local connections, phone service, etc.
 - \$2 million so far this year.

K-12 IT Initiatives

2011 Legislature funded network connections for K-6 districts
12 school districts = 424 students.
