





Enterprise Architecture


- Enterprise Architecture (EA) is a collaborative effort involving 142 people from 27 agencies from all three branches of North Dakota government.
- EA and IT Planning are supported by one FTE in the Enterprise Services Division.
- In 2001, EA replaced ITD's process for setting technical standards. In 2010, Business Architecture was added to the EA initiative in the form of the Project Management domain team.





EA Governance


The State Information

EA Governance

The Study Teams and Ad Hoc Committees are assigned by either the ARB or AT to perform a specific assignment that does not fall under the jurisdiction of any one Domain Team.

EA Process of Establishing Standards

- Need is identified
 - Request for new standard
 - Request to modify existing standard
 - Request for technical review
 - Domain team initiates
- Domain team develops the proposed standard
- Architecture team approves the DT proposed standard, forwards it to the ARB

EA Process of Establishing Standards

- Architecture Review Board approves the standard submitted by the AT, forwards it to SITAC
- SITAC reviews the standard and advises the CIO
- EA website is updated, communication sent to IT Coordinates on new / modified standard
- Agencies comply with the standard or request a waiver


State IT Projects

- In even-numbered years, agencies submit IT plans that provided input to the State IT Advisory Committee's ranking process
- SITAC prioritized 13 projects in Sept. 2010
- 9 of the 13 were included in the Executive Budget Recommendation and funded by the Legislature

State IT Projects

- 8 projects either carried over from previous biennium or originated after SITAC ranking
- A total of 17 Large IT Projects for 2011-13
 - Largest project: \$12,400,000
 - Projects one-million or more: 11
 - Total appropriations: \$35,041,603
