

Business Analysis Service

- ➤ **Definition:** the <u>discipline</u> of identifying business needs and determining solutions to business problems. Solutions often include a systems development component, but may also consist of process improvement, organizational change or strategic planning and policy development.
- Business Analyst Tasks :
 - Understand business problems and opportunities
 - Acts as a liaison among stakeholders
 - Elicit and communicate requirements
 - Analyze, verify, and validate requirements
 - Recommend solutions that enable the organization to achieve its goals



Business Analysis Service

> Benefits of Business Analysis:

- Validate/verify that business needs are met to ensure agencies get what they need, not just what they want.
- Effectively and efficiently identify, manage, and implement changes to the business.
- Act as liaison between business and IT to ensure business needs are accomplished.
- Improve agency strategic planning direction and outcomes.
