Request permission to purchase and install presentation equipment.

Total Cost Not to Exceed \$115,000

CHAMBER VIDEO UPDATE

Intent – Provide mounted cameras and a control station in each chamber.

Provide "frontal" shots of legislators.

Discontinue old digital camera on a tripod from the balcony.

Provide better capability for any changes resulting from rule changes of streaming, storing, archiving chamber video

Location of Videographer:

Cable paths not available in balcony areas.

Recommendations:

At front desk

At an empty members desk



CHAMBER VIDEO UPDATE CONT.

Approval requested:

Determine location of videographer in each chambers.

Request permission to purchase and install chamber video equipment.

Total Cost Not to exceed \$46,000



COMPUTER REPLACEMENT UPDATE

Schedule first meeting after holidays.

Focus will be on laptop size and screen resolution.

Brand is independent as capabilities are common to all vendors.

Tablet technology – deployment, upkeep, training etc.



COMPUTER REPLACEMENT UPDATE CONT.

Results will be presented to LPA for approval at a later date.



CHAMBER VOTING SYSTEM UPDATE



Intent – Replace aging hardware and software with newer technologies.

Existing system uses technology that is approximately 15 years old. (last upgrade 1999)

Provides for:
New member voting buttons and faceplate.

New voting software for leadership/desk-force and integration into current systems.

New full color display boards in both chambers.

CHAMBER VOTING SYSTEM UPDATE CONT.



Current quote is \$930,600

Once ordered – build of display boards would take 12 weeks.

Complete installation and testing would take approximately 4 weeks.

Coordination with facilities needed as wood and brass restoration scheduled through June 2012.

CHAMBER VOTING SYSTEM UPDATE CONT.



Recommendation:

Request permission to continue with project and award to International Roll Call (IRC).

 xxxxxxx@state.nd.us **OLD**

Much of the spam (junk email) you receive today is sent to this old address.

Request permission to notify all legislators and remove the old state.nd.us email addresses from legislative accounts.
