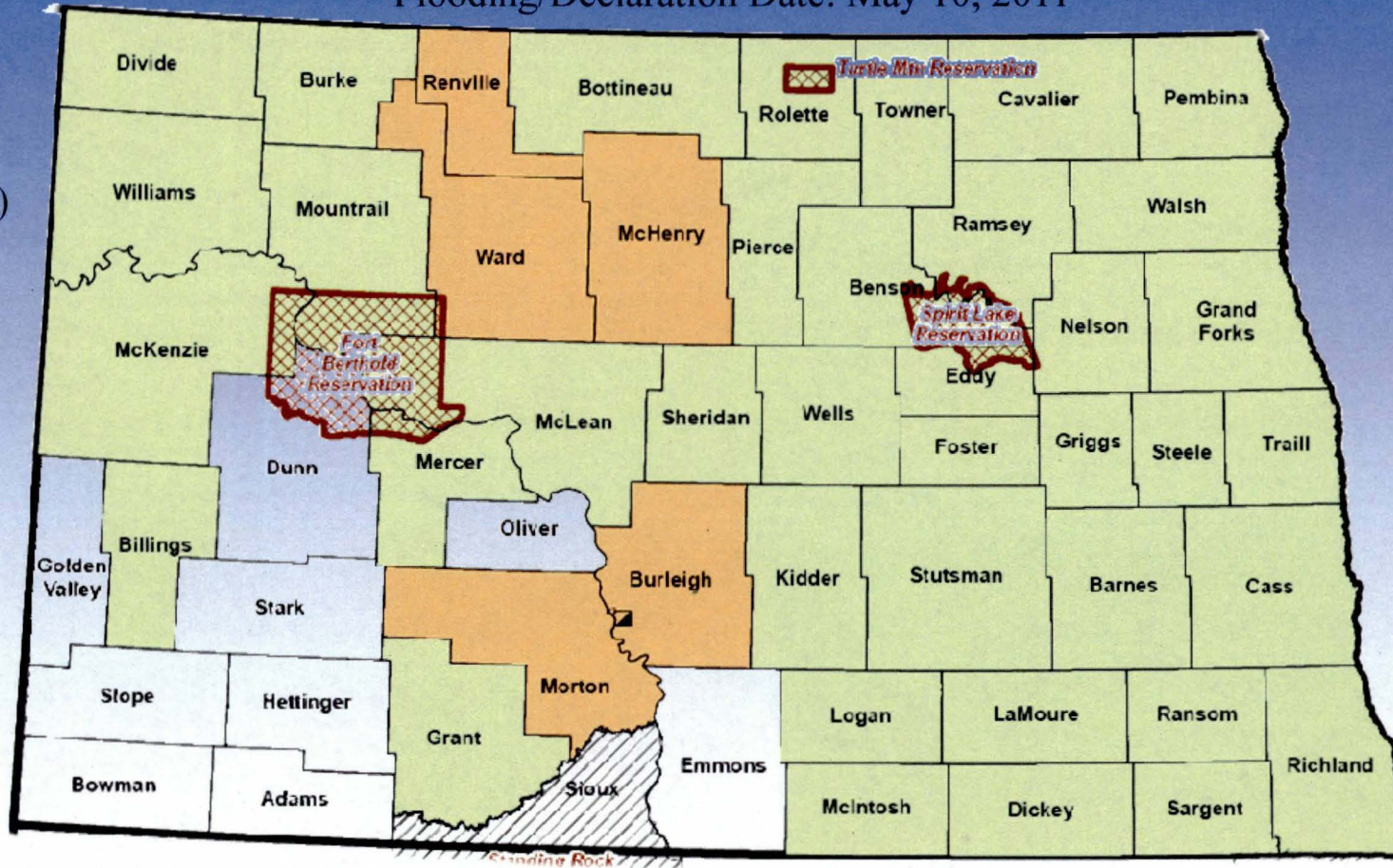
Flooding/Declaration Date: May 10, 2011

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Estimated State Costs (as of July 11, 2011)

- State Direct: \$ 35m
- State Indirect (MAs): \$ 15m
- Public Infrastructure: \$250m
- Individual Assistance: \$ 60m
- Hazard Mitigation Program: \$50m
» \$410 million

Minot Burleigh Morton

132 250 34 Structures 0.5-2.0' deep = Slight Damage

802 125 40 Structures 2.0-6.0' deep = Moderate Damage

2376 50 1 Structures 6.0-10.0' deep = Extensive Damage

805 25 1 >10'+ deep = Complete Damage

4115 450 76 = 4641 Total

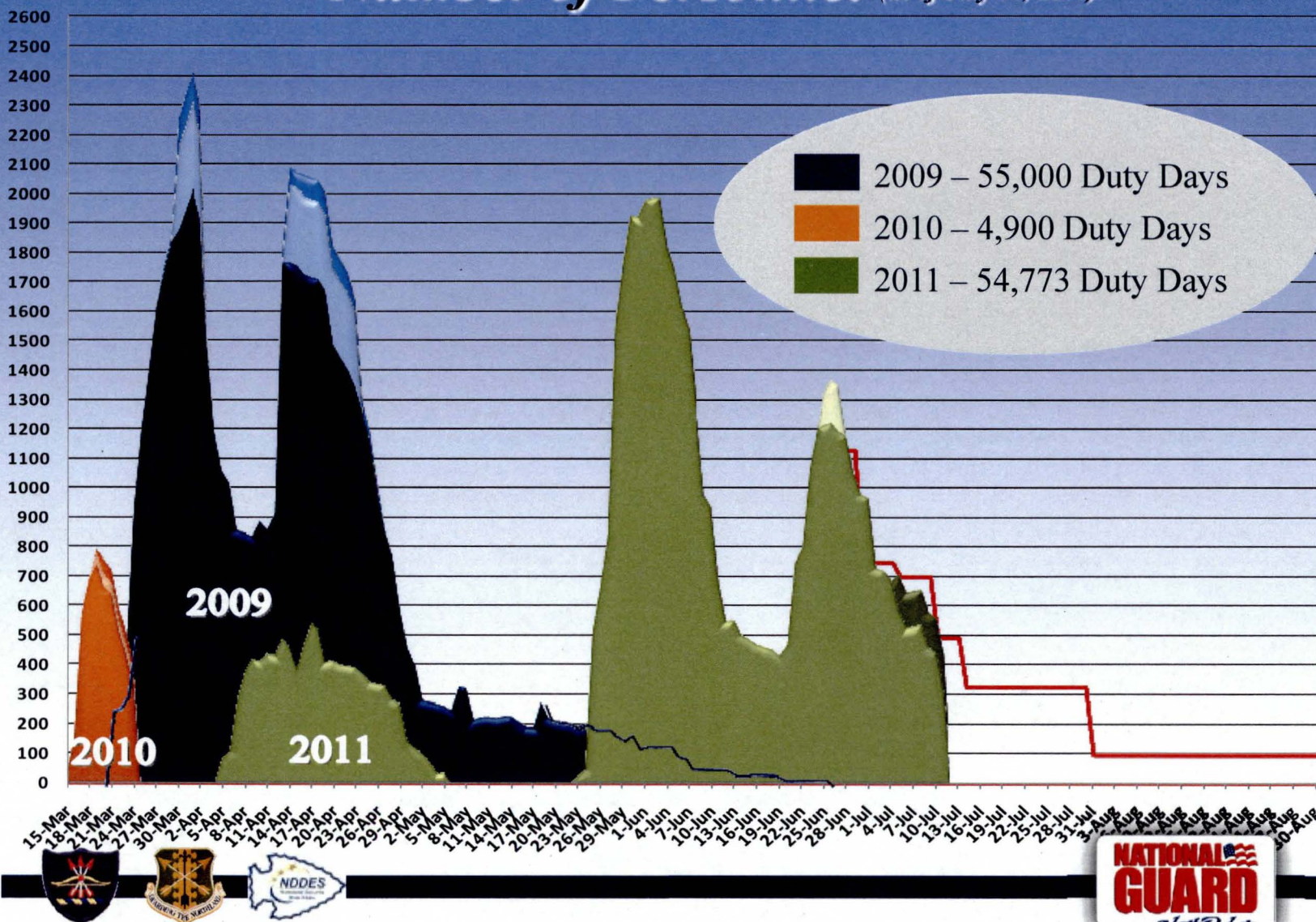

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Number of Personnel (as of July 11, 2011)





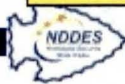

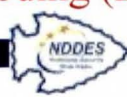
