HOUSE BILL NO. 1341  
(Representatives Kingsbury, Paur)  
(Senator Olafson)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 4-02-27.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the disposition of property used for county fairs; and to repeal section 4-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the filing of agricultural fair exhibition dates.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-02-27.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**4-02-27.3. Disposition of property.**

Any property used for county fair purposes may be sold by the board of county commissioners upon such terms and conditions as the board shall determine, and the proceeds of such sale shall be placed in the county fair fund and used exclusively for county fair purposes, provided that if the county fails to hold a fair within the county for two successive years, any property on hand may be sold and the proceeds of such sale, together with any other unexpended balance in the county fair fund ~~may~~, at the discretion of the board of county commissioners, may be transferred to the county general fund. The levy of the tax authorized by section 4-02-27.2, expenditures of the proceeds thereof, and the conduct of the fair shall be governed by ~~the provisions of sections 4-02-06~~4-02-07 through 4-02-31 to the extent such sections are consistent with ~~the provisions of~~ section 4-02-27.2 and this section.

**SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Section 4-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
