ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1002

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Supreme Court)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
2 and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
3 relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
8 other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for
9 the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

1 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There are appropriated any funds received by the
2 supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not
3 otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the
4 purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period
5 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

6 **SECTION 3. TRANSFERS.** The director of the office of management and budget and the
7 state treasurer shall make such transfer of funds between line items of appropriation for the
8 judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the
9 court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on
10 properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.

11 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
12 amended and reenacted as follows:

13 **27-02-02. Salaries of justices of supreme court.**

14 The annual salary of each justice of the supreme court is one hundred ~~twenty-four~~thirty-four
15 thousand ~~twenty-seven~~one hundred thirty-five dollars through June 30, ~~2010~~2012, and one
16 hundred ~~thirty~~thirty-eight thousand ~~two~~one hundred twenty-eightfifty-nine dollars thereafter. The
17 chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional three thousand ~~five~~eight
18 hundred ~~sixty-two~~fifty-two dollars per annum through June 30, ~~2010~~2012, and three thousand
19 ~~seventy-nine~~hundred forty-sixsixty-eight dollars per annum thereafter.

20 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
21 amended and reenacted as follows:

22 **27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges.**

23 The annual salary of each district judge is one hundred ~~thirteen~~twenty-two thousand ~~six~~nine
24 hundred ~~forty-eight~~ten dollars through June 30, ~~2010~~2012, and one hundred ~~nineteen~~twenty-six
25 thousand ~~three~~five hundred ~~thirty~~ninety-seven dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to
26 travel expenses, including mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official
27 duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are
28 payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled
29 to receive an additional three thousand ~~two~~five hundred ~~eighty-two~~fifty dollars per annum
30 through June 30, ~~2010~~2012, and three thousand ~~four~~six hundred ~~forty-seven~~fifty-seven dollars
31 thereafter.

1 **SECTION 6. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

2 **SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
3 items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13
4 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

16 biennium. The supreme court shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-third
17 legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,
18 and ending June 30, 2013.
