

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study issues related to  
2 development of group housing and crew camps, including infrastructure demands, health and  
3 safety requirements, regulation, and enforcement of regulatory violations.

4 **WHEREAS**, the number of crew camps and other group housing facilities and locations has  
5 grown significantly due to the lack of permanent housing in growth areas of the state; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the increase in population and the need for utilities and services have had  
7 significant impacts on the resources of local governments; and

8 **WHEREAS**, numerous cities and counties have enacted ordinances regulating the siting of  
9 group housing and crew camps and other jurisdictions are considering regulations as this type  
10 of housing continues to expand; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a comprehensive study of issues related to the development of group housing  
12 and crew camps could aid political subdivisions in the planning and development of necessary  
13 infrastructure and appropriate regulations and examine whether state agencies have resources  
14 and expertise to assist political subdivisions in ensuring that the health and safety of the public  
15 are protected while appropriate housing facilities are available to meet the needs of employers  
16 in the state;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OF NORTH**  
18 **DAKOTA, THE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

19 That the Legislative Management study issues related to development of group housing  
20 and crew camps, including infrastructure demands, health and safety requirements, regulation,  
21 and enforcement of regulatory violations; and

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and  
23 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
24 the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly.
