- Receive report from the State Department of Health before January 1, 2012, April 1, 2012, and July 1, 2012, on the status and outcome of the department's creation of an inventory of material gathered relating to abortions and a report outlining the department's practices in gathering the items in the inventory (2011 House Bill No. 1297, Section 15)
- Receive report from the Health Council by July 1, 2012, regarding the findings of its review of current health care bed recommendations and whether changes should be made to better serve the population of North Dakota (2011 House Bill No. 1040, Section 3)
