1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to health insurance utilization reports.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **26.1-36.4-09. Health insurance utilization reports.**

- 7 1. ~~Once each calendar year, any employer with fifty-one or more eligible employees~~Upon
8 receipt of a request of an employer or upon termination of health insurance coverage
9 for any employer, ~~the employer is entitled to a report from the an~~ insurer or
10 administrator of that employer's employee health plan ~~which shall provide the employer~~
11 with a health insurance utilization report that includes a monthly accounting for the
12 most recent ~~twenty-four-month~~thirty-six-month period of the:
13 a. The total number of insured or covered employees,~~the~~
14 b. The total premiums paid,~~and the~~
15 c. The total benefits paid on behalf of the employer's health plan; ~~and~~
16 d. A detailed claims experience report that outlines payments made on behalf of the
17 health plan, including a large claims report.
- 18 2. ~~Insurers~~An insurer shall provide the health insurance utilization report pursuant to
19 subsection 1 to an employer within thirty days of receipt of a request for the
20 information.
- 21 3. The information provided pursuant to subsection 1 may not identify specific employee
22 claims or other confidential health care information.
- 23 4. ~~Upon~~For purposes of an employer with fifty-one or more eligible employees, upon
24 notification of termination of health insurance before the end of a benefit period, the

1 terminated insurer, at the request of the employer and within thirty days of the request,
2 shall supply the succeeding or new insurer a health insurance utilization report of all
3 deductibles and coinsurance payments for each employee covered by the employer's
4 health insurance plan for the most recent benefit period as provided under
5 subsection 1.
