1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the securities
2 commissioner; and to create and enact a new subsection to section 10-04-08.1 of the North
3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the examination of applications for approval or the registration
4 by qualification of securities and authority of the securities commissioner.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other income, to the
9 securities commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the
10 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

19 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 10-04-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
20 created and enacted as follows:

21 When applicable, in examining an application for approval of a securities offering or in
22 examining an application for registration by qualification of a securities offering, the
23 commissioner may utilize the criteria set forth in statements of policy adopted by state

- 1 securities regulators through the North American securities administrators association
- 2 which are in effect when the commissioner exercises discretion under this section.
