15-62.2-04. Funds received by the state board of higher education - Where deposited - How appropriated - How expended.

Funds received by the state board of higher education must be deposited in the state treasury in special funds to be known as the North Dakota student financial assistance fund and the North Dakota scholarship fund and expended in accordance with legislative appropriations. ~~All expenditures from these funds must be paid by warrant check prepared by the office of management and budget upon vouchers submitted by the state board of higher education.~~
