1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-30-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to Sunday closing.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-30-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **12.1-30-02. Items prohibited from sale or rental on Sunday - Exemptions.**

7 ~~Except for items sold at hobby shows, craft shows, fairs, exhibits, occasional rummage-~~
8 ~~sales including garage sales or other sales for which a sales tax permit is not required, and~~
9 ~~tourist attractions that derive at least fifty percent of their annual gross sales from seasonal or~~
10 ~~tourist customers~~

11 1. Except as otherwise provided under this section, the sale or rental of any of the
12 following items between the hours of twelve midnight and twelve noon on Sunday is
13 prohibited:

14 1-a. Clothing other than work gloves and infant supplies.

15 2-b. Clothing accessories.

16 3-c. Wearing apparel other than that sold to a transient traveler under emergency
17 conditions.

18 4-d. Footwear.

19 5-e. Headwear.

20 6-f. Home, business, office, or outdoor furniture.

21 7-g. Kitchenware.

22 8-h. Kitchen utensils.

23 9-i. China.

24 10-j. Home appliances.

8 2. Subsection 1 and subsection 1 of section 12.1-30-01 do not apply to:

9 a. The items sold at hobby shows, craft shows, fairs, exhibits, occasional rummage
10 sales including garage sales or other sales for which a sales tax permit is not

11 required, and tourist attractions that derive at least fifty percent of their annual
12 gross sales from seasonal or tourist customers.

13 b. The sale or rental of items for which the the governing body of a city or county, by
14 ordinance or other special authorization, has specifically authorized the sale or

15 rental to take place before twelve noon on Sunday.
