

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with Senate Amendments
ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1312**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of corrections and rehabilitation
2 to relocate the Missouri River correctional center; to provide a transfer; to provide for a report to
3 the legislative management; and to provide legislative intent.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND**

6 **REHABILITATION - REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.** There is appropriated
7 out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum
8 of \$200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of corrections and
9 rehabilitation for the purpose of developing a plan for relocating the Missouri River correctional
10 center to the youth correctional center site, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending
11 June 30, 2015. The plan must include a determination of facilities, services, and activities that
12 may be shared by the Missouri River correctional center and the youth correctional center. The
13 department must present the plan to the legislative management by July 1, 2014.

14 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER - STATE PENITENTIARY LAND FUND -**

15 **LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the
16 state treasury, the sum of \$12,000,000, which the office of management and budget shall
17 transfer on July 1, 2013, to the state penitentiary land fund established in section 54-23.3-04.
18 The funds transferred and interest earned on the moneys transferred must be used for costs of
19 relocating the Missouri River correctional center. It is the intent of the legislative assembly that if
20 the sixty-fourth legislative assembly does not approve the relocation of the Missouri River
21 correctional center, the funds transferred be returned to the general fund.

22 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - MISSOURI RIVER CORRECTIONAL CENTER**

23 **LAND - REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.** It is the intent of the sixty-third
24 legislative assembly that once the Missouri River correctional center is relocated to the youth

- 1 correctional center site, all remaining land be transferred to the parks and recreation
- 2 department for recreational purposes and not for residential, business, or industrial purposes.
- 3 The parks and recreation department shall develop a ten-year plan for the property to be used
- 4 for recreational purposes. The parks and recreation department shall report on the plan and
- 5 progress to implement the plan periodically to a committee designated by the legislative
- 6 management.
