1 A BILL for an Act ~~to amend and reenact section 5-03-08 of the North Dakota Century Code,~~
2 ~~relating to the deposit of wholesale liquor tax collections; to create a substance abuse~~
3 ~~prevention grant fund; and to provide an appropriation to the department of human services;~~
4 ~~and to provide for a legislative management study.~~

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** ~~Section 5-03-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended~~
7 ~~and reenacted as follows:~~

8 ~~— 5-03-08. Taxes and fees deposited in the general fund and substance abuse~~
9 ~~prevention grant fund.~~

10 ~~— All Seventy five percent of moneys collected by the tax commissioner under this chapter~~
11 ~~must be transferred to the state treasurer, within ten days after the end of the month in which~~
12 ~~they were collected, and deposited in the state general fund. Twenty five percent of the moneys~~
13 ~~collected must be deposited in the substance abuse prevention grant fund.~~

14 ~~— SECTION 2. SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION GRANT FUND. There is created in the~~
15 ~~state treasury a substance abuse prevention grant fund. Moneys in the fund are available,~~
16 ~~subject to legislative appropriations, for substance abuse prevention programs.~~

17 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.** There is
18 appropriated out of any moneys in the ~~substance abuse prevention grant~~general fund in the
19 state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ~~\$4,688,500~~\$600,000, or so much of the
20 sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing
21 competitive grants for substance abuse prevention, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013,
22 and ending June 30, 2015.

23 **SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SUBSTANCE ABUSE**
24 **PREVENTION.** The legislative management shall consider studying, during the 2013-14 interim,

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1 the development of a comprehensive plan to coordinate various sources of funding for
2 prevention and cessation of risk-associated behaviors. The legislative management shall report
3 its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
4 recommendations, to the sixty-fourth legislative assembly.
