

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with Conference Committee Amendments
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2074**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 26.1-02.1-05 of the North
2 Dakota Century Code, relating to penalties for insurance fraud; and to provide a penalty.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 26.1-02.1-05 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 1. a. A violation of section 26.1-02.1-02.1 is a:
 - 7 (1) A class A felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
 - 8 fifty thousand dollars;
 - 9 (2) A class B felony if the value of any property or services attempted to be
 - 10 obtained exceeds fifty thousand dollars;
 - 11 (3) A class B felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
 - 12 ten thousand dollars but does not exceed fifty thousand dollars;
 - 13 (4) A class C felony if the value of any property or services attempted to be
 - 14 obtained exceeds ten thousand dollars but does not exceed fifty thousand
 - 15 dollars;
 - 16 (5) A class C felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
 - 17 fiveone thousand dollars but does not exceed ten thousand dollars; and a
 - 18 (6) A class A misdemeanor in all other cases.
- 19 b. For purposes of this section, the value of any property and services must be
20 determined in accordance with ~~subsection 6 of section 12.1-23-05.~~
