SENATE BILL NO. 2177
(Senators Miller, Dotzenrod)
(Representatives Kempenich, Maragos, Nathe)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to rent allowed for gaming machines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- b. If twenty-one and paddlewheels are not conducted but pull tabs is conducted involving either a jar bar or dispensing device, ~~but not~~ both, the monthly rent may not exceed two hundred seventy-five~~four hundred~~ dollars. If ~~pull tabs is conducted involving both a jar bar and dispensing device,~~ the monthly rent for pull tabs may not exceed three hundred dollars.
