## REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2223

1 A BILL ~~for an Act to provide for a legislative management study; to provide an appropriation;~~  
2 ~~and to provide a transfer.~~ for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to  
3 state governmental facilities.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 ~~**SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY -- ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT-**~~

6 ~~**FACILITY.** During the 2013-14 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the~~  
7 ~~feasibility and desirability of constructing a facility on land owned by the Bank of North Dakota~~  
8 ~~to house economic development-related functions of state government. The study must include~~  
9 ~~consideration of making additional space available in the judicial wing of the state capitol for~~  
10 ~~space needs of the judicial branch. The study must also include a review of options for~~  
11 ~~payments in lieu of taxes if a new facility is constructed.~~

12 ~~— **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION -- LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.** There is appropriated out of~~  
13 ~~any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of~~  
14 ~~\$75,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the legislative council for the purpose~~  
15 ~~of hiring a consultant to assist with the study provided for in section 1 of this Act, for the~~  
16 ~~biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.~~

17 ~~— **SECTION 3. TRANSFER -- BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA PROFITS.** The industrial~~  
18 ~~commission shall transfer \$75,000 from the current earnings and accumulated undivided profits~~  
19 ~~of the Bank of North Dakota to the general fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013,~~  
20 ~~and ending June 30, 2015.~~

21 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE GOVERNMENTAL**  
22 **FACILITIES.** During the 2013-2014 interim, the legislative management shall study the  
23 necessity and feasibility of constructing additional facilities or renovating existing facilities to  
24 house state governmental functions. The study must include consideration of making additional

- 1 space available in the judicial wing of the state capitol for space needs of the judicial branch.
- 2 The study must also include a review of options for payments in lieu of taxes if a new facility is
- 3 constructed. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,
- 4 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fourth
- 5 legislative assembly.
