

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with House Amendments  
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2242**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 and a new  
2 subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to disabled  
3 veterans and hunting fees; and to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 54-17.8-06 of the  
4 North Dakota Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1278, as approved by the sixty-third  
5 legislative assembly, relating to the members of the North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory  
6 board.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

8 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
9 created and enacted as follows:

10 "Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a one hundred percent  
11 service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or  
12 has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the  
13 veteran's total disability ratio to one hundred percent as determined by the department  
14 of veterans' affairs.

15 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
16 created and enacted as follows:

17 For a resident disabled veteran combined general game, habitat stamp, small game,  
18 and fur-bearer license, three dollars.

19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 54-17.8-06 of the North Dakota  
20 Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1278, as approved by the sixty-third legislative  
21 assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:

22 1. There is created a North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board consisting of  
23 twelve members. The governor shall appoint representatives from each of the

- 1 groups listed in this section based upon recommendations made by the  
2 appropriate group. The advisory board consists of:
- 3 a. Four members from the agriculture community. The governor shall appoint  
4 one member from the North Dakota farm bureau, North Dakota farmers  
5 union, the North Dakota stockmen's association, and the North Dakota grain  
6 growers association.
  - 7 b. Two members from the energy industry. The governor shall appoint one  
8 member from the North Dakota petroleum council and one member from the  
9 lignite energy council.
  - 10 c. Four members from the conservation community. ~~The governor shall~~  
11 ~~appoint one member from ducks unlimited of North Dakota, the North~~  
12 ~~Dakota natural resources trust fund, the North Dakota chapter of pheasants~~  
13 ~~forever, and the conservation community at large.~~
  - 14 d. One member from the business community from the greater North Dakota  
15 chamber.
  - 16 e. One member from the North Dakota recreation and park association.
