1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the process for planning
2 transportation projects, including placing an interchange on an interstate.

3 **WHEREAS**, the funding for transportation projects may be a mix of federal, state, and local
4 funds; and

5 **WHEREAS**, there is long-term planning at each level of government before a project
6 begins; and

7 **WHEREAS**, before a construction project may begin, multiple reviews need to be
8 conducted, including environmental and archaeological; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the process of design and management combined with governmental reviews
10 creates opportunities to increase efficiencies in the planning and construction process;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
12 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Management study the process for planning transportation projects,
14 including placing an interchange on an interstate; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17 the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly.
