7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
1	as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
	other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops
	institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch
	research centers, and agronomy seed farm for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
	North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great
,	plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and
i	agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as
	follows:

30	SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount			
31	included in the grand total special funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other			

- Sixty-third Legislative Assembly 1 income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other 2 sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops 3 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 4 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is 5 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium 6 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. 7 SECTION 4. DICKINSON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS 8 **INCOME.** The Dickinson research extension center may spend revenues received from mineral 9 royalties, leases, or easements only for one-time items and not for ongoing operational 10 expenses, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. 11 **SECTION 5. TRANSFER AUTHORITY.** Upon approval of the state board of agricultural 12 research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the director of the 13 main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of 14 section 1 of this Act. Any amounts transferred must be reported to the director of the office of 15 management and budget. 16 SECTION 6. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The board of higher 17 education may adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities in 18 19
 - section 1 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. The board shall report any adjustments to the office of management and budget prior to the submission of the 2015-17 budget request.
 - SECTION 7. EXTENSION SERVICE NEW TECHNICAL SUPPORT FULL-TIME **EQUIVALENT POSITION.** The North Dakota state university extension service may utilize the new full-time equivalent technical support position recommended in the 2013-15 executive budget and included in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, in either the weed science or potato program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

- SECTION 8. UNEXPENDED EXCESS INCOME. Any excess income received by entities listed in section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds or revenues are available and may be expended by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
- **SECTION 9. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for the research greenhouse complex project, as contained in subdivision 4 of section 3 of chapter 48 of the 2005 Session Laws and subdivision 4 of section 1 of chapter 19 of the 2011 Session laws, are not subject to

- the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or related revenues are available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

 SECTION 10. INTERNSHIP. The extension service line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act includes \$250,000 from the general fund for an extension service internship program and agents-in-training program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
- 8 **SECTION 11. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota 9 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 6. Develop a biennial budget request <u>based on its prioritized needs list</u> and submit that request to the president of North Dakota state university and the state board of higher education, and forward its prioritized needs list and request without modification to the <u>office of management and budget and the appropriations committees of the legislative assembly;</u>
 - **SECTION 12. EMERGENCY.** The appropriation for capital projects of \$5,925,000 in subdivision 4 of section 1 of this Act and \$1,900,000 in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
