These maximum prize amounts do not apply to raffles conducted under chapter 20.1-08. The determination of what is a "public-spirited organization" is within the sole discretion of the governing body. An organization shall disclose on the application its intended use of the net income from the gaming activity. A governing body may issue a permit for games to be held at designated times and places."

SB 2320: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the creation of a medication therapy management program for medicaid-eligible individuals.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.

Sens. Mathern, J. Lee introduced:

SB 2321: A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 23-48 and a new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the certification of a community health worker-community health representative and to medical assistance reimbursement.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.
