BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision d of subsection 3 of section 49-23-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- d. Markers used to designate the approximate location of underground facilities must follow the current color code standard used by the American public works association and any flag marker used on agricultural property must be nonmetallic."
