- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the hours motor vehicle headlamps must be illuminated.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **39-21-01. When lighted lamps are required.**
- Subject to the exceptions for parked vehicles, every vehicle upon a highway within this state must display lighted headlamps, taillamps, and illuminating devices as required in this chapter for different classes of vehicles as follows:
  - 4. a. At any time from <u>one hour before</u> sunset to <u>one hour after</u> sunrise, and every farm tractor upon a highway within this state at any time from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise;
    - 2. <u>b.</u> At any time when it is raining, snowing, sleeting, or hailing or during other adverse driving conditions and these conditions do not render a person or vehicle on the highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8 meters] ahead; or
    - 3. c. At any other time when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog, or other conditions, or when there is insufficient light to render a person or vehicle on the highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8 meters] ahead.
- 21 <u>2.</u> Stoplights, turn signals, and other signaling devices must be lighted as prescribed for the use of these devices.
