- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to student identification cards issued by institutions of higher education
- 3 under the supervision of the state board of higher education; and to amend and reenact
- 4 subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to acceptable
- 5 forms of identification to be eligible to vote.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
 and enacted as follows:
- 9 Student identification cards Address required.
- A student photo identification card issued by an institution of higher education must include
- 11 the date of birth and residential address of the student to whom the card is issued. When
- 12 <u>issuing identification cards to students, an institution of higher education shall provide each</u>
- 13 <u>student with information regarding voter eligibility requirements.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-07 of the North Dakota
- 15 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

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- Before delivering a ballot to an individual according to section 16.1-13-22, the poll
 clerks shall require the individual to show identification, which includes the individual's
 residential address and date of birth. The identification may include:
 - A driver's license or nondriver identification card issued by the department of transportation or other official form of identification issued by the state;
- b. An official form of identification issued by a tribal government;
- c. A photo identification card issued by an institution of higher education under the
 supervision of the state board of higher education;

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1	<u>d.</u>	An alternative form of identification prescribed by the secretary of state, if the
2		individual does not possess an official form of identification provided for under
3		subdivision a <u>, b</u> , or b <u>c</u> ; or
4	d. e.	A combination of any of the forms of identification under subdivisions a through
5		e <u>d</u> .
