- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state water commission for the acquisition-
- 2 of efremoval or protection of rural flood-prone properties structures in the Mouse River basin; to
- 3 provide legislative intent; to provide an exemption; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE WATER COMMISSION - MOUSE RIVER BASIN -6 FLOOD-PRONE PROPERTY ACQUISITION RURAL FLOOD-PRONE STRUCTURE 7 **REMOVAL OR PROTECTION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the resources trust 8 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$10,650,000, or so much of 9 the sum as may be necessary, to the state water commission for the purpose of providing 10 grants to political subdivisions for the acquisition of removal or protection of rural flood-prone 11 properties structures in the Mouse River basin, for the period beginning with the effective date of 12 this Act and ending June 30, 2017. The state water commission shall establish criteria for the 13

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - MOUSE RIVER BASIN - FLOOD-PRONE PROPERTY ACQUISITION RURAL FLOOD-PRONE STRUCTURE REMOVAL OR

awarding of grants that must include a 25 percent local match for each grant award.

PROTECTION. It is the intent of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly that a total of \$24,000,000 be provided by the state for the acquisition of removal or protection of rural flood-prone properties structures in the Mouse River basin during the 2015-17 and 2017-2019 bienniums.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTION. The funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds must be continued into the 2017-19 biennium and may be spent only for grants relating to the acquisition of removal or protection of rural flood-prone properties structures in the Mouse River basin.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
